

Introduction:

Agriculture is the first culture of human society, which is the backbone of various developing economies. In India, it is a complex and multi-dimensional enterprise. Agriculture sector is a predominant sector in Indian economy. It has been facing various problems such as low productivity, lack of financial and marketing facilities and lack of unity among farmers. Low productivity, uncertainty and other causes lead to rural indebtedness and farmer suicides. Thus, it is quite correct to observe with M. L. Darling (1925) that "Indian farmer is born in debt, lives in debt and dies in

In order to tackle these problems in an effective manner, the Government of Telangana started the Rythu Bandhu and Dalith Bandhu schemes to support them by providing Investment support to them and to reduce dependency of framers and downtrodden people on money-lenders. This lead to increase their financial position, in turn increases the production and reduce the suicides particularly in rural areas. Our study focused on the grassroots level reflections of beneficiaries of Rythu Bandhu and Dalith Badhu Schemes.

It is observed that the earlier studies suffer from the following gaps which include:

- 1. No attempt is made to evaluate welfare programmes meant for socio-economic development of farmers and depressed sections particularly Dalits in Telangana with a focus on impact on farmer suicides and enabling Dalit entrepreneurs.
- 2. The social and economic implications of Government programs for development of agriculture and also depressed sections, in this context, are not found.

Significance of the Study Paper: The study will find out the relevance and contribution of the new programmes introduced in the agriculture sector in order to increase the production in agriculture and improve the benefits of the farmers and encourage the Dalit people, which in turn reduce farmers suicides in the Telangana state.

Objectives: With this background, the study addressed following specific objectives:

- 1. The broad objective of the study is to understand the impact and implementation of Rythu Bandhu and Dalit Bandhu Schemes in Telangana state.
- 2. To critically examine the perspective of targeted beneficiaries of these welfare programmes.

Hypothesis: The farmer and Dalit welfare schemes would have a positive impact on farmers suicides and empowering Dalit families by encouraging entrepreneurship among their community.

Methodology: The study used a survey and questionnaire methodology for the purpose of collection of the data. The selection strategy was largely driven by the number of small and marginal agricultural farmers and the SC population in three selected districts, namely, Sangareddy, Nalgonda and Nizamabad districts, because among other reasons, they have a large concentration of small and marginal agricultural landholdings and also Dalit Bandu beneficiaries. (selected villages, Gunthapally and Koulampet from Sangareddy, Karegam and Mahammadnagar from Nizamabad, and Domalapalle and Donakal villages from Nalgonda districts.
