- It is also resolved that the career guidance and competitive examination coaching shall be further strengthened for the benefit of the students.


## Resolutions towards Alumni feedback scores

- It is noted that all the alumni has given a very positive feedback on all the parameters and the overall average score is calculated as 8.81 which is a very good sign.
- As the lowest average is calculated for the college building and infrastructure facilities, it is resolved that necessary steps shall be taken to improve the infrastructure facilities to provide more facilities to the students.
- As few students have suggested to provide competitive examination coaching in more effective manner, it is decided that an exclusive training programme shall be conducted every year for 45 days for providing coaching to the students for preparation of competitive examination.
- It is also resolved that necessary steps shall be taken to improve the average score for all parameters by improving the facilities in the college.
