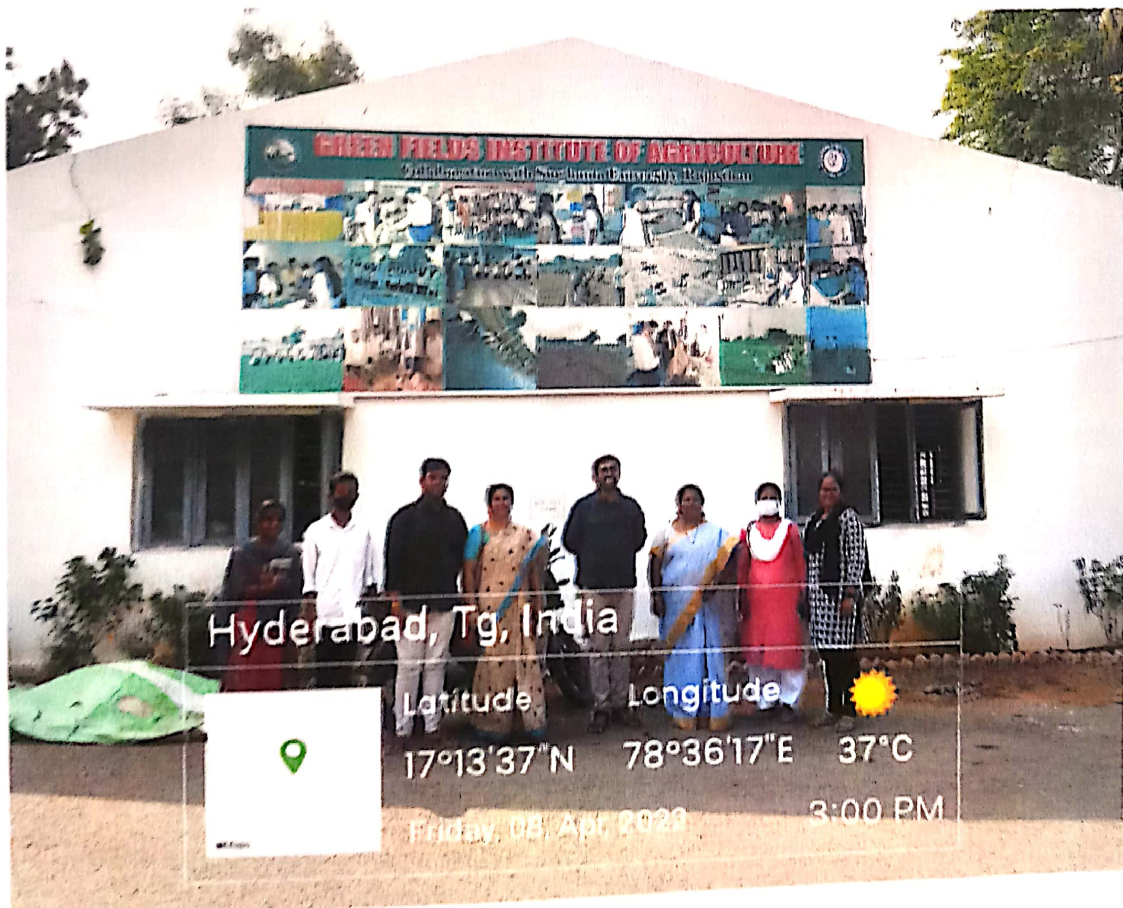


## Department of Botany
