Introduction

Freedom of speech is a principle that supports the freedom of an individual or a community to articulate their opinions and ideas without fear of retaliation, censorship, or legal sanction. Freedom of speech is the right to speak, write and share ideas and opinions without facing punishment from the Government. The first Amendment protects this right by prohibiting Congress from making laws that would curtail freedom of speech. Freedom is very important as this gives us the right to be ourselves, and this helps to work together after maintaining autonomy. Freedom is quite important as the opposite is detrimental to our own well-being and which is inconsistent with our nature.

Objectives

Article 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, adopted in 1948, states that: every one has the right to freedom of opinion and expression, this right includes freedom to hold opinions without interference and to seek, receive and impart information and ideas through any media and regardless of frontiers.

The five freedoms it protects: speech, Religion, press, assembly, and the right to petition the government. Together these five guaranteed freedoms make the the people of the United States of America the freest in the world.

Importance and need of the freedom of speech

- In a democracy, the freedom of speech and expression is one of the prime liberties granted to the citizens. It forms a foundation for other rights granted to citizens, such as the freedom of the press; freedom of the press, in turn, helps in inculcating a better-informed public and electorate.
- It ensures that citizens can express their opinions freely and also hold their political leaders accountable. Also, this freedom ensures that important information is legally shared and circulated among citizens.
- It also provides a platform to make the marginalized and minority voices heard. Issues that concern these groups can be highlighted and brought to the forefront by using the right to freedom of speech and expression.
- The freedom of speech and expression protects the creative license of artists and allows them to develop and share ideas freely. These can be academic writings, satirical work, theatre, cartoons, visual arts and stand-up comedies.
