

Opinions were taken on Likert's five-point rating scale ranging from poor to excellent. 30 respondents have given their opinion. Feedback so collected was analyzed using simple statistical tools. Analysis is presented in Table-1

# FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT



Feedback was given by 30 students. More number (53.3 %) of students expressed that the Curriculum and Syllabi of the Courses is Very good. 46.7% students opined that the effectiveness of curriculum on course outcomes were very good. Regarding inclusion of modern or advance topics in syllabus 53.3 % found it very good. Regarding Clarity and relevance of textbooks equal percentage of students (56.7%) opined that it is very good. Respondents expressed that the Level of usefulness of assignments, seminars, group discussions to improve knowledge base in the course is very good (50%). Arrangement of topics in the syllabus, Relevance of course in implementation of projects, allocation of credits to the courses, evaluation scheme designed for each of the courses, Overall rating of the syllabus of the course were considered very good by 46.7%, 40%,46.7%,43.3% and 56.7% of respondents respectively.

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
# Teacher Feed Back On Course, Syllabus and Its Transactions (2021-2022)

#### The attributes rated **very good** by faculty is as follows:

- Curriculum and syllabus are need based (57.1%)
- Course outcomes are well defined and clear & inclusion of modern or advanced topic in syllabus (66.7%)
- Inclusion of modern or advanced topic in syllabus (57.1 %).
- Clarity and relevance of text books is very good (38.1%).
- Effectiveness of curriculum on course outcomes is very good (42.9 %)
- Extent to which course motivates students to go for higher Studies/ research/competitive exams (42.9%)

- Better to provide images of writers and poets in the next publication.

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


#### COURSE/CURRICULUM/SYLLABUS FROM ALUMINI(2021-2022)

# ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK OBTAINED ON COURSE/CURRICULUM/SYLLABUS FROM ALUMINI (2021-2022)

The feedback received from alumni is very encouraging. 84% of the respondents strongly agreed to be proud of being students of GDC, Korutla, whereas 4% of them stayed neutral. 60% students strongly agreed that Learning in the college is useful in their career .68% students strongly agreed that College administration motivates alumni in academically & financially strengthening GDC, Korutla . 4% of the respondents strongly disagreed .52% of them opined that the Syllabus—is need based. Effectiveness of course / curriculum in attaining communication skills and social responsibility, Effectiveness of course / curriculum to apply knowledge in real life situation, Relevance of current curriculum for employability were graded as excellent by 56%, 60% & 52% respondents respectively.

- o Rooms should be lightened and furniture to be provided
- Admissions should increase

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## **ACTION INITIATION ON FEEDBACK**

#### AY 21-22

A meeting was conducted by IQAC under the chairpersonship of Dr.N.Vasavi, Principal to discuss about the feedbacks analysed by the feedback committee and SSS. The reports were placed before the staff members and the following decisions were taken.

#### Regarding Course, Syllabus and Its Transactions.

- Most of the students are satisfied with the course and syllabus.
- It is advised to continue educating students about PO,PSO & CO.
- Conduct bridge courses
- Provide advance learners with material on modern topics.
- Advised faculty to enroll on online platforms for Faculty development programmes to upgrade knowledge.
- It is decided to motivate alumni to strengthen college academically and financially
- More efforts are needed to increase admissions.
- It is decided to motivate a greater number of students to give feedback through online mode.

### Analysis Of Students' Feedback on Teachers and SSS

- All the staff were appreciated for scoring excellently in feedback from students on teachers performance.
- Appreciated staff members for effective communication, excellent approach to teaching, fairness in internal evaluation.
- It is decided to continue teaching learning with the same spirit.
- Provide handouts to students ahead of class so that they can easily understand the topic while lecturing.

- Increase efforts to enhance the cognitive, social and emotional growth of students and do the necessary follow up for the tasks assigned.
- Educate students about the career opportunities.
- Enhance student centric methods.
- Compulsory utilisation of ICT tools for effecting teaching learning.

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
