1. Solid waste:

The waste is generated by all sorts of routine active cities carried out in the college that includes paper, plastic, glass, metals food etc. the waste is segregated at each level

And source. The administrator supervisor in each block ensures that the waste in each floors collected at designated time intervals. The block clean workers in each floor collect, clean segregate and compile the waste in the dustbins provided at each floor. The floor dustbins are emptied and is taken to the dumping yard provided by the college

The institute has conducted an authorized vendor who collects the waste from the designated place, segregates them, recycles them and disposes them at the landfills authorized by the govt.

2. Liquid waste:

Liquid waste generated by the college is 2 types

Sewage waste

Laboratory and other waste

The above waste is treated through sewage treatment and effluent treatment plants and the water is used for flushing in toilets

The hazardous lab and other waste disposal, a standard operating procedure have been evolved for handling the hazardous waste disposal system. For disposal of hazardous waste, government approved agency collects these from the designated point.



3. E- waste management :

Memory chips,, mother board ,compact discs etc generated by electronic equipments such as computer, phones, printers, fax and other machines are recycled properly

, instead of buying a new one buyback option has taken for technology up gradation. The E- waste generated by hardware which cannot be reused or recycled is being disposed off centrally through government authorized vendors
