Introduction

Rythu Bandhu Scheme also Farmer's investment Support Scheme was announced by the Chief Minister of Telangana, **K. Chandra Shekhar Rao** at Farmer's Coordination Committee Conference at Jayashankar Agriculture University on 25th February 2018.

It was launched on 10th May 2018 at Dharmarajpalli Village in Karimnagar. It is a welfare programme to support farmer's investment for two crops a year (Rabi and Kharif season). At present budget is 14,800crores. This is a first direct farmer investment support scheme in India, where the cash is paid directly. Rythu Bandhu means'' **Friend of Farmer''**.

Aims and Objectives

The main objective of Rythu Bandhu Scheme is to provide financial support to the farmer's of Telangana. Relieving the farmers from debt burden and not allowing them to fall in the debt trap again. Under this Scheme Rythu Bandhu, the government of Telangana aims to provide Rs.4000 to every eligible farmer of 1acre of land at last year. At present year to provide Rs.5000 for every 1acre of land to the farmer's. The Scheme aims to cover 1.42 Crores acres of land a total of 31 districts of the state of Telangana.

The implementation of Rythu Bandhu Scheme is mainly concerned with the revenue department of the state. The revenue department is responsible for issuing Pattadar passbooks for the maintenance of the land records vividly. The Pattadar Passbook is issued by the revenue officials under the Record of Rights Act and is also considered has a proof of ownership.

The state government started crediting money directly to the farmer's bank accounts under this scheme.

We went to the Agricultural Office and visited DEO, AO and Computer programmer and collected the data about Rythu Bandhu Scheme and also visited farmers to collect the information from them.

Observation and Results:

In the year 2018 Yasangi, 134141 farmers got assistance and the farmers got Rs.1374517430 for this Yasangi 2018. Under the Rythu Bandhu Scheme in Wanaparthy District.

In the year 2021 Vanakalam season 157663 farmer's got assistance and got Rs.1,82,58,97,536 under this Rythu Bandhu Scheme. The person who has more land then, he got deposit more amounts in their banks. The person who has less land then, he got deposited less amount in their banks.

The most number of eligible farmers are from Pangal and the least number of farmers are from Srirangapur.

We noticed that among 14 Mandals, Pangal farmers got highest amount, this is because they have more land.

Conclusion:

The idea behind this scheme is to support the farmer's so that their productivity could increase. The crops which will be benefited from the scheme during Rabi and Kharif seasons i.e., Yasangi and Vanakalam.

Under the Rythu Bandhu Scheme, only ownership of farmers are benefited who have Pattadar passbooks, tenants are losing under this scheme. Eventhough, It is a great privilege of introducing this scheme for the farmers in Telangana State. It is a great initiative by the government of Telangana for the beneficiary of farmers. This Rythu Bandhu Scheme is also ideal for other states.
