- Slip Tests are conducted after completion of every unit in respect of all papers of commerce. Slow learners are identified on the basis of the performance of the students in Slip Tests and Remedial Coaching is offered to them through Mentor Mentee system.
- The students are enabled to visit the offices of local Chartered Accountants to make them aware of GST and Income Tax.
