



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is intended to promote cooperation and collaboration between the Department of Telugu, Journalism and Women Empowerment Cell of Nagarjuna Government College (A), Nalgonda and Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), Nalgonda, Ministry of Youth Affairs & sports Government of India. Represented by B. Praveen Sing, District Youth Officer (DYO) recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions/organizations from the establishment of Institutional links, hereby agree to enter into this agreement for the following purpose.

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic (such as certificate courses awareness programmes and training programmes) and educational cooperation, establish a collaborative program to encourage the students on the need to preserve the cultural splendor, heritage, and arts of Telangana between the two Institutions/Organizations and to cooperate in their mutualinterest.

ABOUT NAGARJUNA GOVERNMENT (NG) COLLEGE

The district of Nalgonda which was part of the Hyderabad State was under the rule of Asaf Jahi dynasty when it was merged into the Indian Union in 1948.

A rural based district with over eighty five percentage of its population living in villages, it has a rich cultural heritage as the oldest centre of learning dating back to the Buddha's period, the prominent one of its seminaries located in Nagarjuna Sagar and the other ones situated in Kolanupaka, Panagal, Rachakonda and Pillalamarri of the united Nalgonda district.

However, facilities for contemporary higher education in the district were initiated being provided only after 1955. The earliest one is our Nagarjuna College which was established in July 1956 by a small group of enlightened and enthusiastic individuals who gathered under the banner of Nagarjuna College Samithi with an avowed and determinant aim of bringing quality higher education to the rural poor and backward sections of the district of Nalgonda and its surrounding areas.

This college which was begun with just 60 pupils in pre-university classes in 1956 became within a very short while, that is, by the following academic year 1957-58 a first grade institution with degree courses in arts, science and commerce.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh took this college into its fold in October 1958 and there have never been instances of looking back since then. And it has been growing from strength to strength as the years rolled on serving the educational needs of this backward district of the

Telangana region and today it has as many as 4120 students on the rolls.

The institution was accorded recognition under 2(f) and 12 (B) in 1972 of UGC act of 1956 and ever since then it has been receiving assistance from the UGC.

The college was accredited by the NAAC with B++ grade in 2004. And in the year 2007 it was conferred with the status of autonomy. The college was accredited by the NAAC with A grade in 2012. Accredited B grade by NAAC(3rd Cycle) in 2021. The college that celebrated its Golden Jubilee in 2006 is a forerunner in the realm of higher education in this part of the state, all other institutions in and around looking forward to its advice and direction with a craving for an emulation of its ways.

The academic ambience of the institution is enhanced by the exemplary achievements of its outstanding Alumni.

The college with highly qualified faculty and state-of-the-art in frastructure creates an environment conducive for higher learning works with a vision to bring in holistic development of students with student centered pedagogical models. The college stands first in Degree Online Services Telangana (DOST) admissions with intake of 1500 completely being filled with meritorious students.

ABOUT NEHRU YUVA KENDRA SANGATHAN, NALGONDA, MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

Nehru Yuva Kendras were established in the year 1972 with the objective of providing rural youth avenues to take part in the process of nation building as well providing opportunities for the development of their personality and skills.

In the year 1987-88, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) was set up as an autonomous organization under the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, to over see working of these Kendras. NYKS is the largest grassroots level youth organization; one of its kind in the world. It channelizes the power of youth on the principles of voluntarism, self-help and community participation.

Over the years, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan has established a network of youth clubs in villages, where Nehru Yuva Kendras have been set up.

NYKS has targeted to identify areas of harnessing youth power for development by forming Youth clubs, which are village level voluntary action groups of youth at the grassroots level to involve them in nation building activities. The core strength of NYKS lies in its network of youth clubs.

Youth Clubs are village based organizations working for community development and youth empowerment.

The basic objective for creation of youth clubs is to render community support through developmental initiatives involving activities with particular focus on youth empowerment. The implementation of programmes and activities of youth clubs is based on local needs and requirements by mobilizing resources from various government departments and other agencies, which include both national, State level and multilateral institutions. The youth clubs and its member volunteers from the base of the NYKS's vast national rural network.

Youth Clubs are formed and encouraged to participate in sports, cultural and local development activities. Youth leadership is developed in the course of formation and sustenance of youth clubs. This leadership becomes highly useful in creating: -

- Networks of volunteership.
- Opportunities of participation in fundamental democratic practices of polity and development;

- Instruments of empowerment of youth like skill-generation, awareness creation about health, life skills, and self-employment.

IMPLEMENTATION

All programs or activities such as certificate courses awareness programmes and training programmes or implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget forth eprogram of activity as then eedmay arise.

Each of the participating institutions shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the parties.

The parties will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

NAGARJUNA GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (FOR DEPT OF TELUGU) UNDERTAKES TO:

Motivate the students for participating in this Telugu typing, DTP and Photoshop certificate course organized by the organization NYK, Ministry of youth affairs and sports, Government of India provide Infrastructure which has been need for this certificate course.

Motivate students to participate in the projects designed by NYKS.

NYKS UNDERTAKES TO-

- Networks of volunteership-Organize
- Instruments of empowerment of youth like skill-generation, awareness creation, life skills, and self-employment.

Extend technical and financial support to interested students in different projects.

DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of both the institutions/organizations i.e., the Dept of Telugu, Journalisam and Women Empowerment cell Nagarjuna Government Degree College and NYKS for a period of 5 Years (2021-2026) and is subject to revision of modification by mutual agreement without any financial implications

Exit Clause:

The roles for participating parties have been clearly defined. In case, if any one wants to exit for not meeting the commitment or otherwise can do so with a 15-daynotice.
