It promotes afforestation programme by providing free saplings, conducting small business programme explaining the importance of the trees. It stands against all activities related to deforestation.

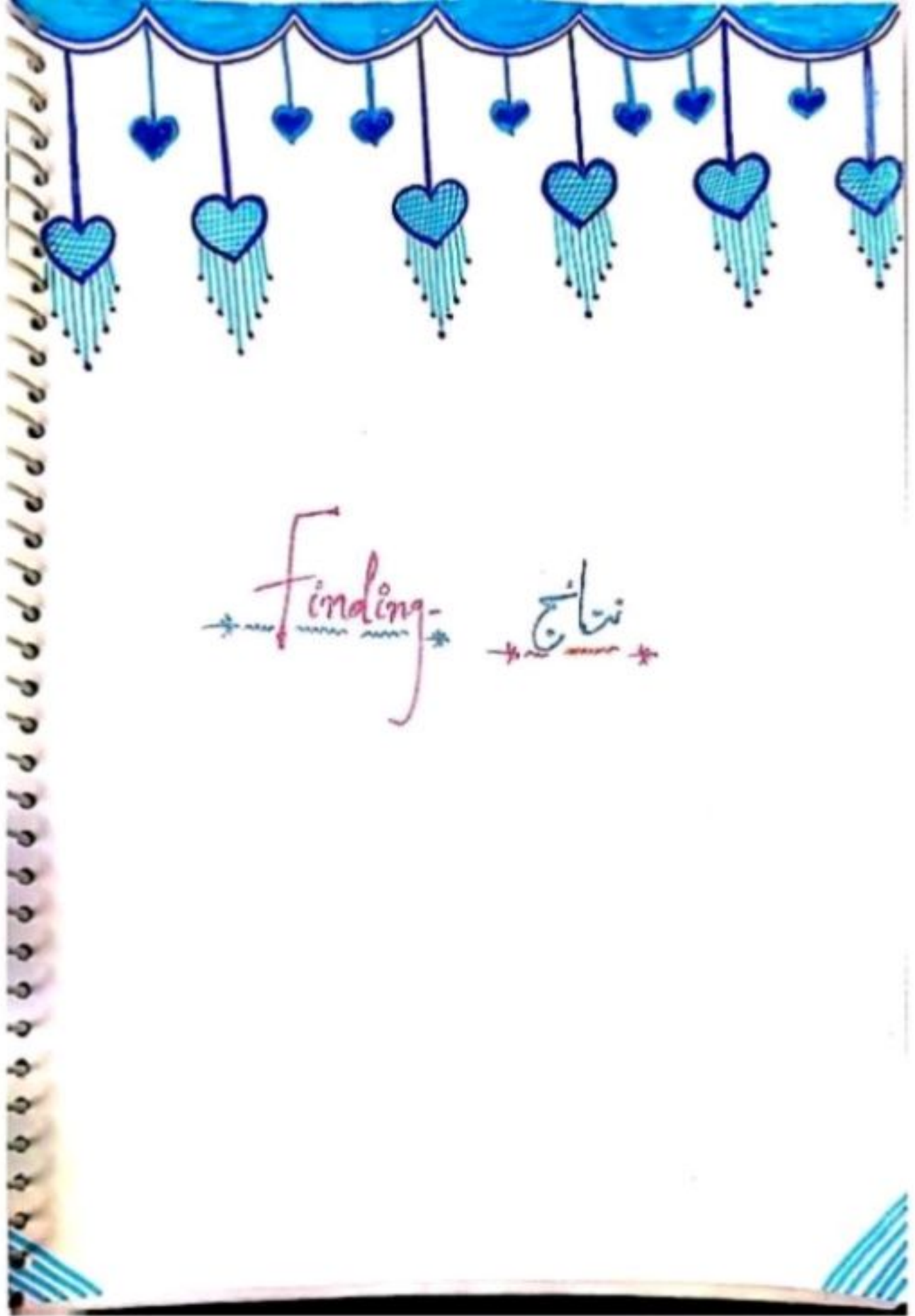
Its main aim is to protect the trees and plants from unnecessary damages.
