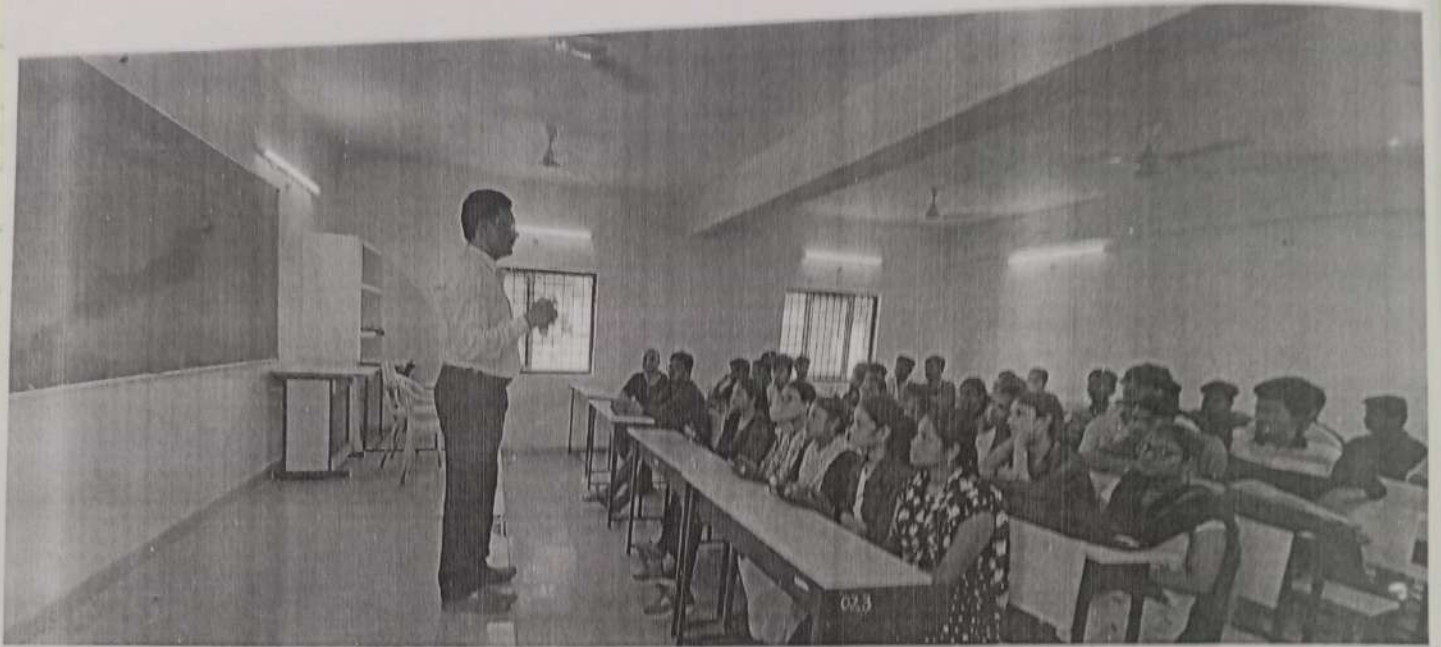
Consumer club Convenor Dr. V. Prabhatkar, HOD Dept of Commerce explained and interacted with the students and clarified the doubts raised by the students.



CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Commerce department of GDC Khairatabad has conducted Consumer awareness programme for I, II, III, B.Com students.



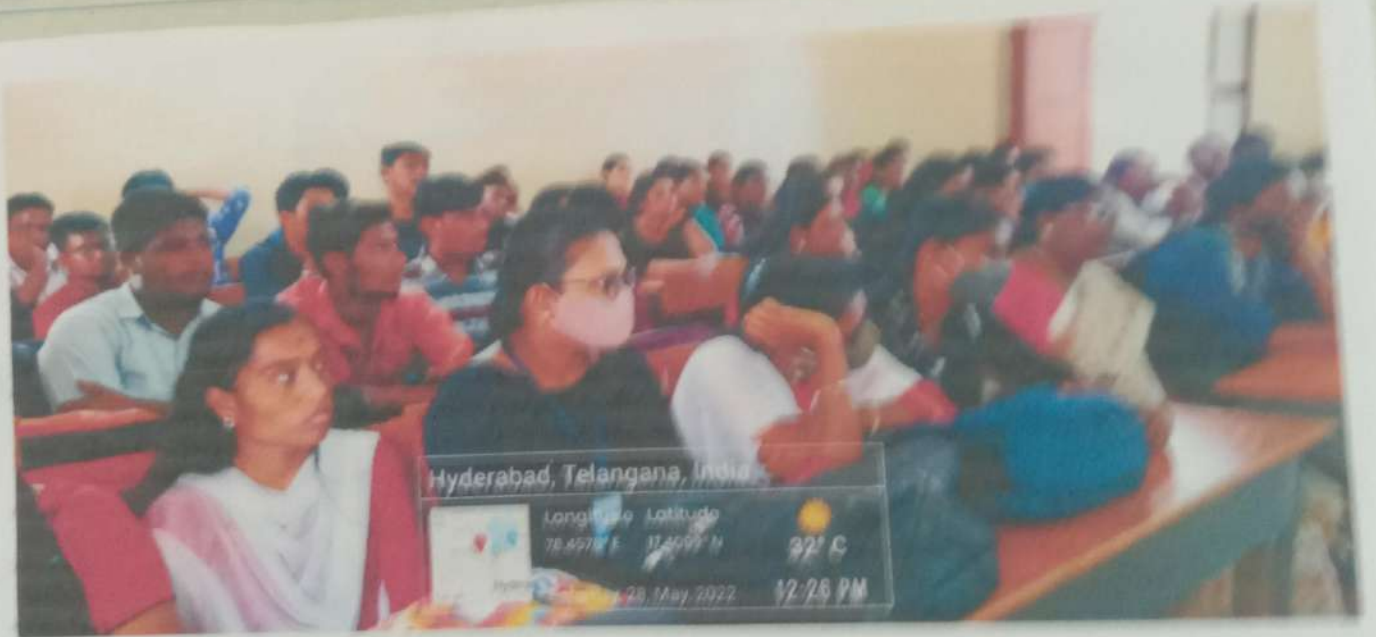

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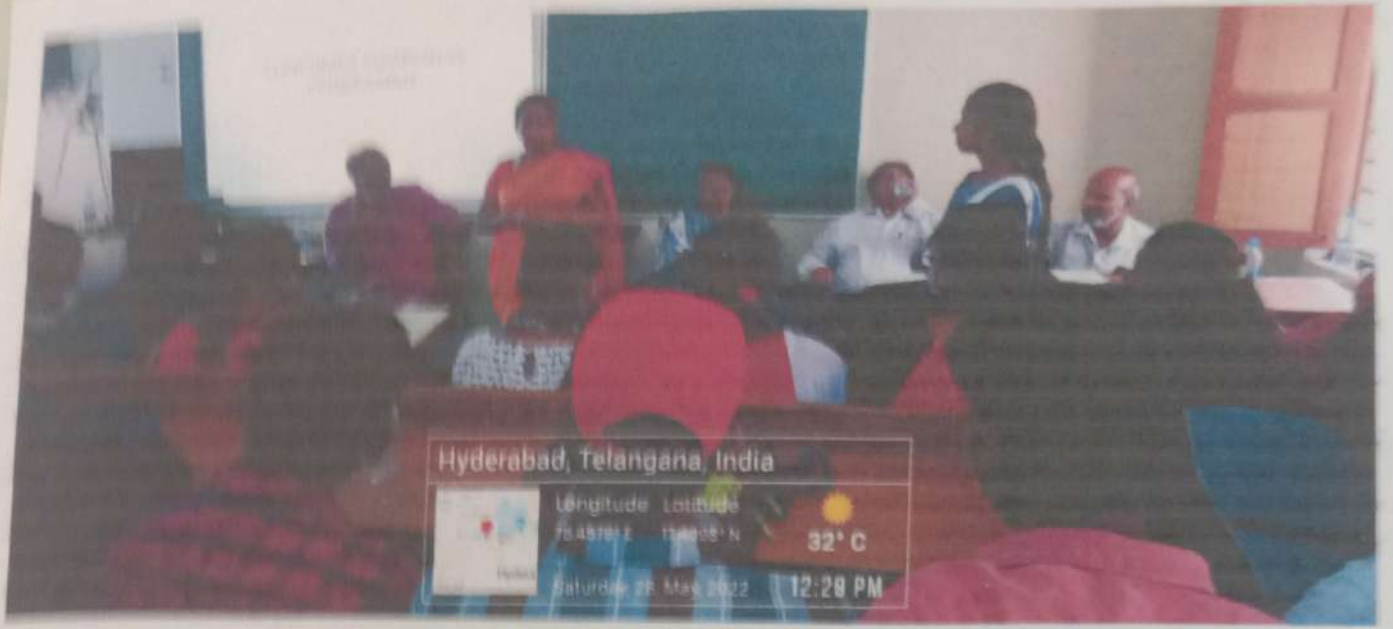
