**1. FIELD TRIP TO INCOIS – 08.02.2019**

Field trip was conducted for the students of B.Sc. (M.S.Cs & M.P.Cs) I years to encourage them towards the field of Science and Technology. INCOIS (Indian National Center For Ocean Information Services) is an Autonomous body under the Ministry of Earth Sciences of Govt of India is located in Pragathi Nagar Hyderabad, was chosen for this purpose. Permission was sought from the concerned authority through proper channel (Official communication from Principal of the college) to conduct the field trip on 08/02/2019. Two faculty members Smt. K.Swarna, and Sri. M. Ravi, Guest faculties of Computer Science, along with the 20 number of students visited INCOIS on 08/02/2019.

Arrangements were made by the INCOIS Group to demonstrate the various Innovative things happening in Ground Station of INCOIS like Tsunami Early warning system, Potential fishing zone, ocean state forecasts(waves,currents,sea surface temperature etc.)which was given for fisher mans oil and natural gas industries. The research scientist Dr. Srinivas Inspire faculty, and students of the college by demonstrated the concepts of Ocesionography through the power point presentation and also demonstrated the working of super computers in the field of ocesionography.

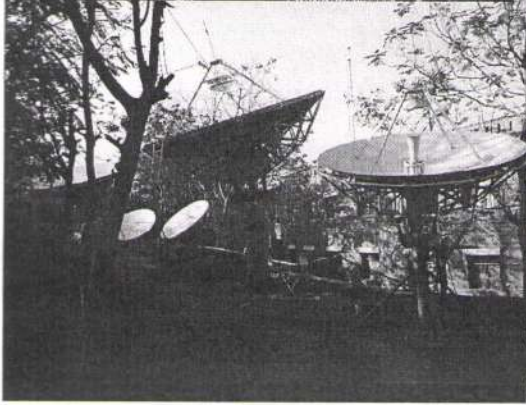
The following were demonstrated to the students:

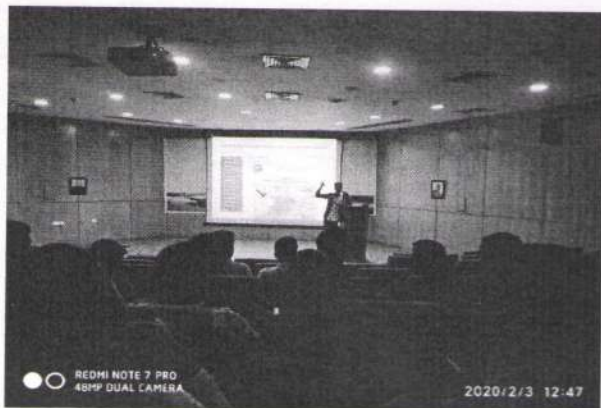
### Tsunami
