The Public Administration, as an academic discipline took birth in India only after its Independence. The first full pledged independent academic department was established in the Nagpur University in 1948. Since then, the discipline has slowly and firmly spread to different universities in the country. The discipline has got greater patronage in the Osmania University under the academic leadership of Prof M.A. Muthalib.




