Orientation program for BA students

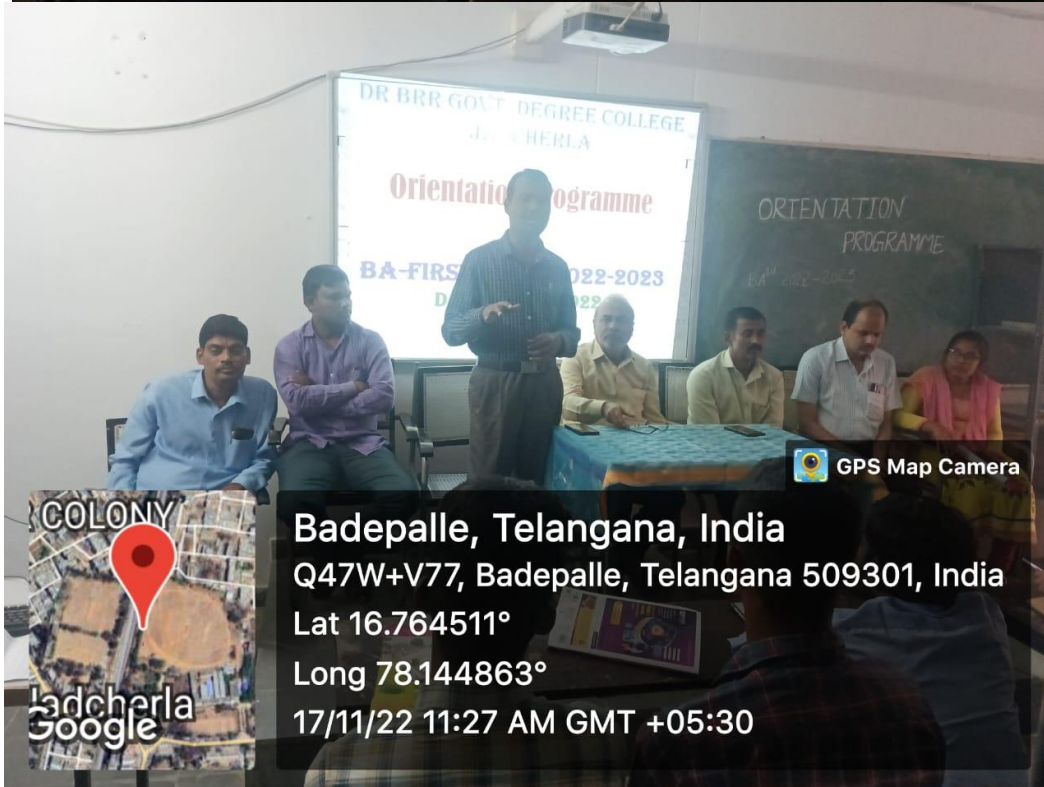
