



Voter's day 2023

Komaram Bheem birth anniversary April 3,2023

Komaram Bheem's birth anniversary is celebrated on August 22 every year. He was a tribal leader who fought for the rights of the Gonds in the erstwhile Hyderabad State. He is considered a hero in the Telangana movement.

Komaram Bheem was born in 1901 in the village of Govindapuram in the Adilabad district of Telangana. He belonged to the Gond tribe, which is one of the largest tribal groups in India.

Bheem was educated in a local school, but he left school early to join the Gond resistance movement against the Nizam of Hyderabad. The Nizam was a Muslim ruler who ruled over the Hyderabad State from 1724 to 1948. He was oppressive towards the tribal people, who were forced to pay high taxes and were denied basic rights.

Bheem quickly became a leader of the Gond resistance movement. He was known for his bravery and his commitment to fighting for the rights of the tribal people. He led several successful raids against the Nizam's forces.

In 1924, Bheem was betrayed by one of his own men and was killed in an ambush. His death was a major blow to the Gond resistance movement, but his legacy continues to inspire people in Telangana and across India.
