

Sri MD. Jaleel, Head Department of English, welcomed all to the programme. He explained and exhorted on importance of translation studies. He explained that Günter Grass and Ravindra Nath Tagore became famous because their writings were translated into other languages. He went through the concepts of translation and their importance in literatures. He gave a tribute to all great translators.

Mr A. Vishweshwara Sharma explained about the salient features of translation. He explained that we think in our mother tongue and speak in other tongue: with reference to English or Hindi.

Dr Rapolu Srinivas, head department of Telugu averred that the translations from other languages into Telugu enriched Telugu language. He explained about the job opportunities that are available to translators. He averred that translations are called transcreations as they require the skill of creation. He explained word to word translations and concept translations. He acclaimed the role of the first well-known and greatly revered trans creation of the Maha Bharatha from Sanskrit into Telugu, viz. by Nannaya, Tikkana and Errana.

Vice-Principal, Mrs. M. Praveena exhorted on the need to look again at the translations as a whole from a different perspective. She explained the role of greatest translation works in English literature and their significance in changing lives of millions. Principal, Dr K S S Ratna Prasad, exhorted the role of translations in world literatures. He quoted a few sentences from English to explain the importance of translations.
