

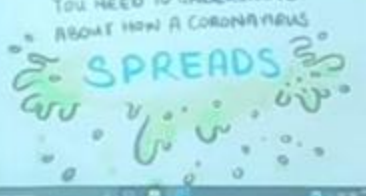
DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES
