**ANALYSIS OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY - 2022-23**

A student satisfaction survey or SSS has been conducted in the institution for the academic year 2022-23 in the month of April 2023. The method of random sampling has been used to select the students. 65 students of the HEI were given the opportunity to participate in the survey. A questionnaire containing 20 questions with multiple choices was handed to them and they were asked to complete the survey. Blank space was provided at the end of the questionnaire, facilitating students to express their views, opinions and suggestions for the betterment of the institution.

**Point wise analysis of the survey**

- 1. Coverage of syllabus: 90% of the students are satisfied with the coverage of syllabus.**
- 2. Teacher's preparation for the class: More than 75% students are happy with the preparation of teachers for the class.**
- 3. Communication ability of the teacher: more than 60% students are satisfied with the ability of teachers in communicating.**
- 4. Teacher's approach to teaching: 57% students believed that the teachers are innovative approaches while teaching**
- 5. Fairness in internal evaluation: 72% affirmed their faith in the fairness of the internal exams.**
- 6. Discussion of assignment performance: most of the students felt that there should be more discussion on assignment performance**
- 7. Internship/field visits/ student exchange: students desired more number of field visits**
- 8. Mentoring process: 80% students felt that the mentoring system of the college is robust.**
- 9. Providing opportunities to learn and grow: students want more opportunities to learn and grow.**
- 10. Information about COs and Pos: students agreed that they were given information about Cos and Pos.**

11. Mentor following up assignment task: according to students, subject teachers, not mentors are following the given task.
12. Teachers illustration of examples and applications: 79% students are of the opinion that teachers are providing good illustrations and examples.
13. Teachers Identifying the strength of the students: majority of the students opined that the teachers are able to identify the strength of the students
14. Teachers identifying students' weakness and helping them: majority of the students opined that teachers are able to identify the weakness of students and help them.
15. Continuous quality improvement in the institution: students strongly agreed that there is continuous quality improvement
16. Use of student centric methods: according to students there is moderate use of student centric methods
17. Encouragement to participate in extracurricular activities: majority of the students strongly agreed that the institution encourages extracurricular activities.
18. Institution's efforts to inculcate soft skills/life skills: students felt there is a moderate effort by the institution to inculcate soft skills and life skills
19. Percentage of students using ICT tools: as per students more than 70% teachers use ICT tools.
20. The overall quality of teaching learning in the institution: more than 80% students strongly agreed that the overall quality of the teaching learning in the institution is very good.
