As a part of I B.Sc curriculum one day field trip was organized to Central Nursery ,Narsapur by the Department of Botany Government Degree College, Narsapur, Medak District .

**Objectives of the Field trip:** 1.To familiarize the students with the flora and ecology of the region.



2. To get practical knowledge about different varieties of plant species.

The major objective was to familiarize the students with the plants growing there. Also to acquaint them with the importance of flora of forest area .





A group of 30 students were accompanied by Botany department In charge Mrs.B.RukminiDevi. As a part of their curriculum students collected plants from the surrounding areas for Herbarium preparations after visiting the nursery.

The nursery was beautified with different species of plants like Bambusa, Aegle marmelos, Albizia lebbeck, Ficus bengalensis, Ficus religiosa, Mangifera indica, Terminalia arjuna, Andrographis paniculata, Ocimum sanctum, Aloe vera, Asparagus racemosus, Phyllanthus acidus, Emblica officinalis, Syzizium cumini, Daturametel, Thanikaya, Gachhakaya, Nemalinara, Lawsonia inermis, Juvvi, Pithecalobium, Annona squamosa, Naravepa, Casuarina, Azadirachta indica, Tectona grandis etc.




Afterwards Students learned about nursery techniques like seed propagation, collection of seeds ,sowing of seeds ,Raising of plantlets from seeds, preparation of nursery beds, watering timings, preparation of organic manures, panchagavya etc and their formulations.
