


Feedback on the Institution 2018-19



1. Student Feedback



STUDENT FEED BACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2019-20:

- 936 samples were collected for the academic year 2018-19 from all courses offered.
- Student feedback collected on both college facilities and individual lecture performance.
- Feedback on individual lecturer was analyzed and suggestions were conveyed to the teachers concerned for betterment
- 5 ratings were provided i.e. Excellent, Very good, Good, Average & Poor.
- In the analysis it was found that, less than 1% students opted POOR, with regard to column no's 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 23 and 24. These columns are belonging to curriculum and co-curricular activities, working of different committees in the college, library facilities, laboratory and sports facilities and working of teaching and non-teaching staff in the laboratories and library.
- Hence, overall performance of the lecturers, librarian and non-teaching staff in extending their services at various levels are excellent.
- Column no. 17 belongs to Wi-Fi and internet facility. 8% consider the facilities offered by the college very good while 17% consider it excellent. 34% of the students consider the facilities are good and 13%consider it just satisfactory and 26% commented it poor.
- Column 20 provides girls common room. 11% evaluate the college facilities are very good, while 17% score it as outstanding. 36% of students feel the facilities are good, 18% think they are just adequate, and 18% think they are poor.
- Column 22 is for Washroom Cleanliness and maintenance. 17% rate the college's facilities as very good, while 8% rate it as exceptional. 34% of students think the facilities are good, 24% think they are just adequate, and 17% think they are poor

After a careful analysis of the student feedback, the following recommendations/ resolutions made under the chairman ship of the principal to enhance the quality of teaching learning process.

- Feedback analysis was presented in staff council, discussed and unanimously resolved by
 the staff council/Communicated to university through BoS members/ subject wise
 departmental conference at various university academic meetings regarding the student
 feedback on syllabus transaction.
- Resolved to pay more attention towards poor or an average performance areas and suggestions were conveyed to the teachers concerned for betterment The report was sent to the higher authorities through principal.
- Subject wise analysis was discussed and courses where other teaching methods required were identified.

Action Taken

- Given access to the Wi-Fi for all the students
- To provide the clean washrooms and hygienic environment in the college, a committee
 was formed with three faculty members along with three students, committee members
 are instructed to visit the washrooms on regular basis.
- As many of the students are from the rural background they are unaware about the hygienic and cleanliness of the toilets. We conducted multiple awareness programs for all the students about health and hygienic.

Parent Feedback



In the analysis it was found that, all the parents are responded positively on all areas covered in the feedback form, but in the coulomb no. 11 which belongs computer lab facilities, some of the parents suggested that computer lab should be equipped with more number of computers. The overall feedback from the parents shows that parents are well satisfied with the facilities and efforts taken by the institute.

1. Alumni



2. Employers Feedback (Teachers Feedback)


