ANALYSIS REPORT OF STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY ON
INSTITUTIONAL PERFORMANCE (2022-23)

The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) cell was conducted a student satisfaction survey on institutional Performance in Government Degree College- Bellampally, for the academic year 2022-23.

The survey focused on overall institutional performance and learning experiences of the students. As a part of the survey data has been collected through the distribution of questionnaires among the students. In the questionnaire Students were asked as ranking system '0' being poor, '4' being excellent. The data collected was compiled and evaluated. Fifty feedback forms were collected, analyzed and action has been taken.

The brief observation about the survey is as follows:

Overall the students were satisfied with the Teaching facility. Many of them were expressed their satisfaction towards teachers' illustration of concepts through examples, applications and conducting remedial classes. They were satisfied with the adoption of teaching techniques and fairness in evolution. Majority of the students have been given positive feedback about their Departmental Activities and the efforts taken by the teachers.


The students have expressed satisfaction regarding the mentorship programme and grievance redressal system and counseling cell.

- Request to provide sufficient classrooms and lab equipments.
- Asked for Extension Lectures on different topics other than curriculum.
- More Field trips, Seminars, study projects are asked.
- Provision of sports facility.
- Purified water facility.
