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

The College was taken over by the state government on 1-09-1959 and it acquired permanent affiliation to the Osmania University in 1972. Eventually the affiliation was transferred to the Kakatiya University, Warangal. The College attained Autonomy Status during the year 2015-16.

Under the able and missionary administration of Principals like K.Y.L Narasimha Rao, D.Natesan, Bankat Lal Agarwal, Dr.K.S.R. Sharma and M. National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was established in 1994 as an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission (UGC) with its Head Quarter in Bangalore. The mandate of NAAC as reflected in its vision statement is in making quality assurance an integral part of the functioning of Higher Educational institutions (HEI's).

NAAC's instrument is developed to assess and grade institutions of higher education through a three step process and make the outcome as objective as possible.

NAAC has identified a set of seven criteria to serve as the basis of its assessment procedures. NAAC has categorized the Higher Educational Institutions into three major types (University Autonomous College and Affiliated/Constituent College) and assigned different weightages to these criteria under different key aspects based on the functioning and organizational focus of the three types of HEI's.



Dear Students,

Analysis of the survey is done using software which will aggregate the responses and generate the score of Student Satisfaction Survey which is important Key Indicator in overall grade of institution.

In SSS, twenty of the twenty one questions will be objective in nature, while one question is open ended to elicit observations and suggestions for improvements thereby providing an opportunity to the student to give suggestions and criticisms in their own words. The questionnaire consists of several facets of the teaching learning process.
