Feedback is an essential element of the Teaching -Learning process. The college has a mechanism of continuous evaluation of the teaching -learning process as a part and parcel of IQAC. The Committee prepares a Questionnaire on various aspects of syllabi and courses. These Questionnaires are distributed to the students randomly and the feedback is collected and analyzed. Besides students, the committee collects feedback on curricular aspects and courses from other stakeholders as Faculty and Alumni. The feedback collected from the stake holders is analyzed to identify the gaps, weaknesses and strengths of the curriculum offered, with a view to strengthen the teaching -learning process and environment. The analysis report of the feedback collected for the academic year 2022-23 has been summarized based on the data enumerated through distribution of response sheets (with six parameters). The questionnaire is framed on the aspects as syllabus, content of the syllabus; its applicability and relevance to the societal needs; its usefulness in pursuing higher studies and so on. On the whole, almost all stakeholders are content with the curriculum and the structure of the course.





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

The College, being affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Nalgonda, follows the curriculum prescribed by it. The college follows a continuously reviews the curriculum through feedback. The feedback collected from stakeholders is analyzed by the IQAC committee. A Staff Council meeting, Under the chairmanship of the Principal is convened to consider various aspects of the feedback analysis. It has been observed that in general, majority of respondents expressed their satisfaction with the outcomes.
