

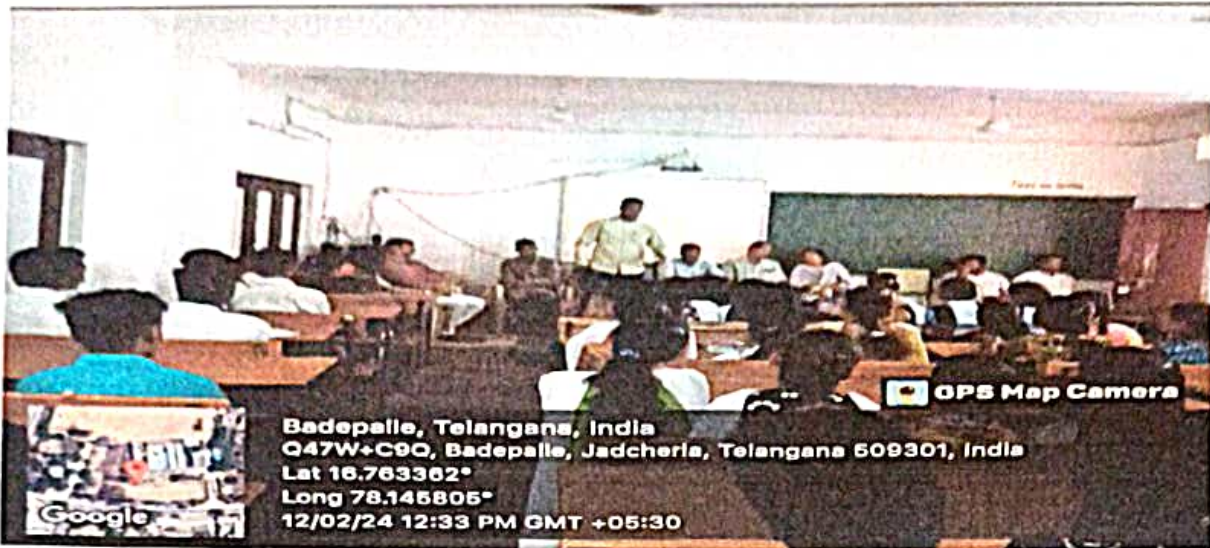
**Birth Anniversary of Gaddar**

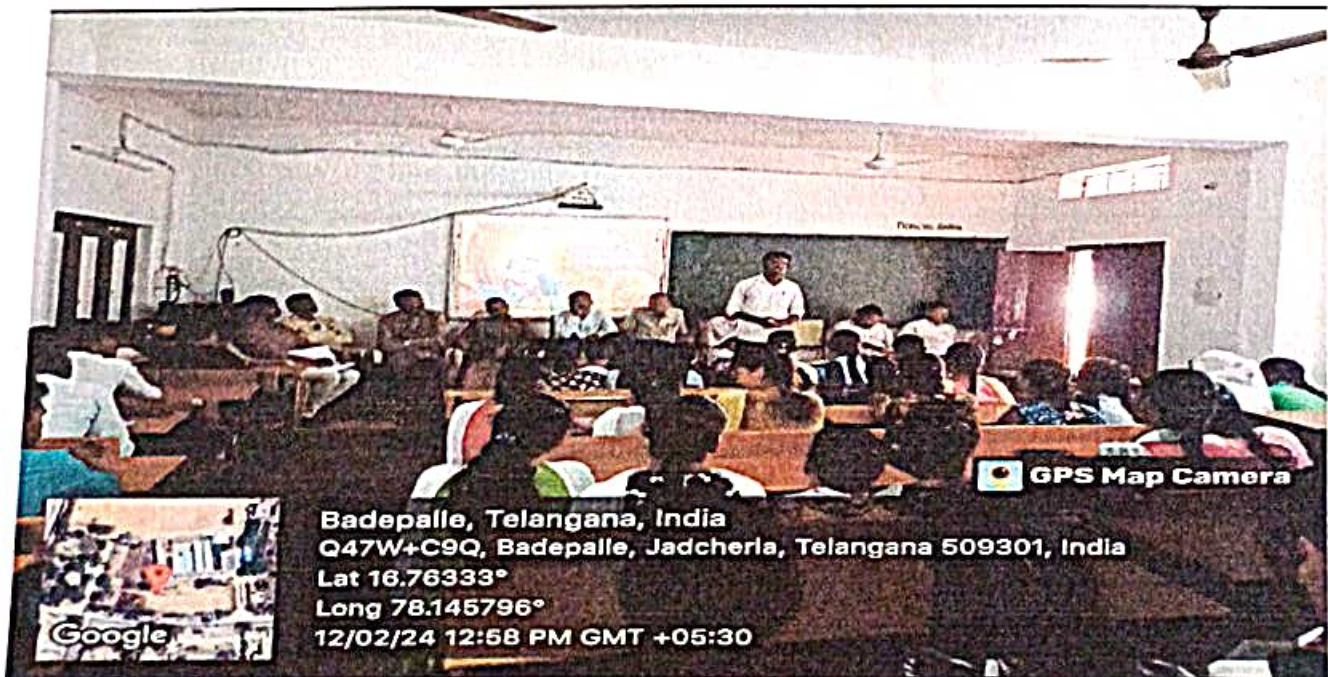

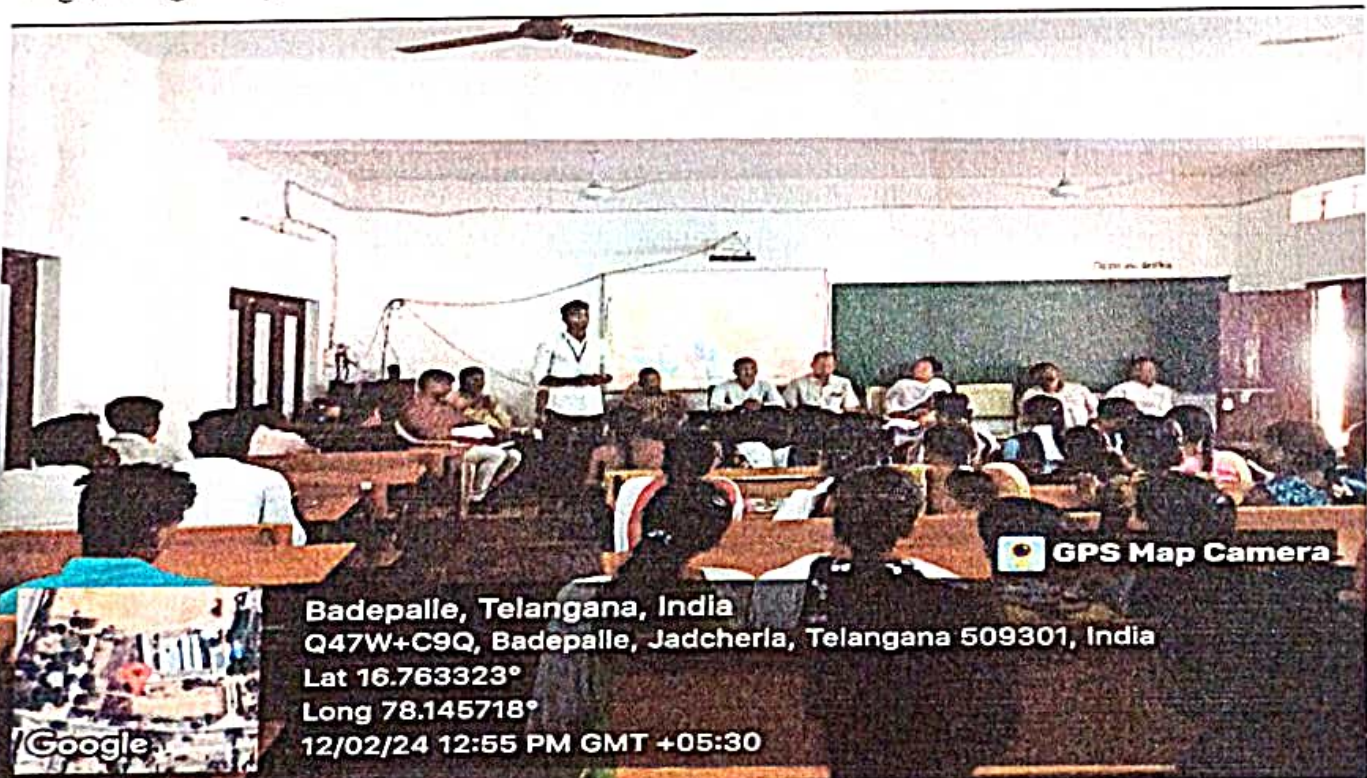
O. Shiva Kumar, lecturer in Political Science, elaborated on Gaddar's sacrifices for creating an egalitarian society

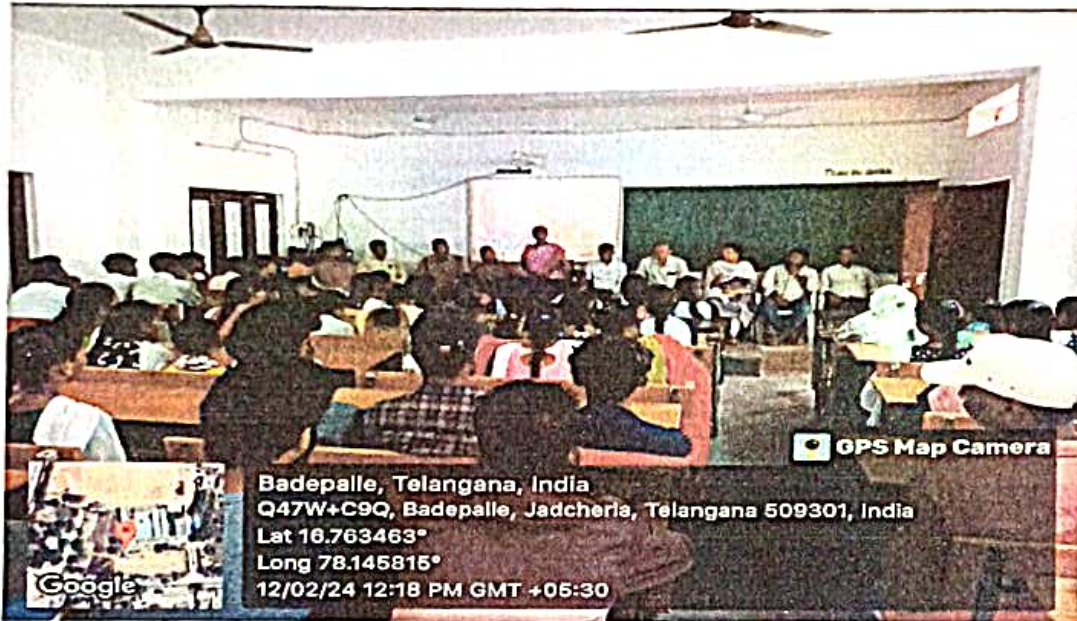
C. Beeraiah, Head, Department of History Addressing the programme
