Environment Protection Training Research Institute (EPTRI), Hyderabad Assessment of Market Potential for Single Use Plastic (SUP) & Availability of alternatives to SUP in selected ULBs

REPORT

Vide File No.CCE-AC/GEN/22/2022-ACADEMIC CELL, dated 16.10.2022, EPTRI, Hyderabad has conducted Training of Trainers (ToT) Programme on Climate Change & Single Use Plastic to carry out Assessment of Market Potential for Single Use Plastic (SUP) and availability of alternatives to SUP in the Telangana State. Seven ULBs have been selected based on the population to carry out the survey through interview method with individual consumers, stockiest, retailers, local shopkeepers and with the bulk consumers.

GHMC is one among the seven ULBs and three colleges from GHMC have been identified for carrying out the assessment. Govt. City College is one of the three colleges and three faculty members from the college were trained on 17th October, 2022 to carry out the assessment from 14thNovember, 2022.

Vide File No. CCE-AC/GEN/22/2022-ACADEMIC CELL dated 12.11.2022, **Dr.G.Srinu**, Asst. Prof. of Sanskrit, **A Ramana**, Asst. Prof. of Commerce, **B.Sofia Rani**, Asst. Prof. of Botany have selected students from various UG programme to do the survey in the allotted circles

i.e. Khairatabad & Secundrabad. A total of 30 students have carried out the assessment from 14^{th} to 16^{th} Nov' 2022 under the supervision of their teacher mentors.

The survey was done by the enumerators/students successfully in the allotted areas of the respective circles. They have interacted with the individual consumers, retailers, local shopkeepers and with the bulk consumers to know about the usage of SUP and the awareness among public regarding the alternatives to SUP.

As per the feedback submitted by the students, they are happy on being selected for the survey. They said that it was a good opportunity for them to go into public and conduct a study. As per their feedback, retailers/shop keepers are hesitant to disclose the information of SUP used and the expenditure met for the same. Most of them are aware of the damaging effect on our environment and they said that individual should be

given more awareness and government should take necessary action on the manufacturing of SUP. When SUP is not available in the market, everyone will go for the alternatives. Students have come up with the ideas that

- > The damage caused by the single use plastic can be publicized through reels and shorts as done in the case of use of ghutka, cigarette etc.
- ➤ The Educational institutions should give wide awareness to the students on the damage caused due to SUP and usage of alternatives, so that they can spread the same in their communities and also will becareful, watchful on the SUP.
- > The consumers may be given a small discount if they carry an alternative to SUP when they go to market.

Further students are also happy that the survey has helped them to enhance their communication skills and listening skills. The following students have participated in the


