

There will be 4 units and 4 credits each for I and II semesters of Telugu for B.A/B.Com./ B.Sc / B.B.A (Second Language) and 3 credits each for rest of the semesters (i.e III, IV, V and VI).

In this regard, 2 internal exams will be conducted and the average of them will be considered for the awarding of marks except for the I Semester. For I Semester, only ONE internal assessment test will be conducted. Five marks are allotted for assignment and 5 marks are allotted for student seminar / Group Discussion / Any other assessment the teacher deem fit.

In this regard, 2 internal assessments tests will be conducted and average of them will be considered for awarding of marks except for the I Semester. For I Semester, only ONE internal exam will be conducted. Five marks are allotted for assignment and 5 marks are allotted for student seminar in addition to regular Seminars.
