

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN**  
**GOVERNMENT CITY COLLEGE, NAYAPUL, HYDERABAD AND**  
**PEGASUS FARMACO INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED, HYDERABAD**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is taken on Wednesday day of 14.01.2020 by Government City College, Nayapul, Hyderabad and Pegasus Farmaco India Private Limited, Hyderabad.

The parties share the goals of academically supporting activities and support Government City College, Nayapul, Hyderabad in terms of encouraging Chemistry pursuing students by facilitating field trips and providing academic guidance. The MOU formalizes the commitment of the parties to work together to provide educational support services to student and faculty to improve the overall academic environment particularly in the department of Chemistry at Government City College, Nayapul, Hyderabad.

**I. Objectives of the MOU:**

This MOU is entered with the following specific objectives:

- a) To promote and enhance academic support to Govt. City College, Hyderabad in the form of permitting students to field trips/industrial visits to Pegasus Farmaco India Private Limited, Hyderabad.
- b) To provide necessary advice and suggestions for effective implementation of curriculum programs like certificate courses and add-on courses in the Department of Chemistry of Govt. City College, Hyderabad.
- c) To provide placement assistance to the students of Chemistry of Govt. City College, Hyderabad
- d) To encourage the students in undertaking research based and skill based program at Department of Chemistry of Govt. City College, Hyderabad.
- e) To support faculty to undertake research in the specific and domain areas of the Pegasus Farmaco Ltd.



## II. Technical Areas of Collaboration:

- Support services in Pharmaceutical Chemistry for the students of B. Sc students - Guiding the students in the areas of Industrial Chemistry
- Preparation of domestically useful chemical items by the students in the college campus

## III. Proposed Modes of Collaboration:

The proposed MOU would facilitate in the form of providing career guidance to the students of Chemistry and create awareness on future prospects in the domain area of Chemistry.

## IV. Terms and Conditions:

The academic assistance and support is proposed to be extended by PFI, PVT Ltd Hyderabad is purely on voluntary basis and no financial commitment in the form of payment of honorarium to the host institute i.e. Govt. City College, Hyderabad

## V. The Role of College

The Govt. City College, Hyderabad agrees to:

1. Whenever PFI authorities visit the college on academic purpose the college would provide transport facilities to the resource persons or guests visiting the Govt. City College, Hyderabad
2. Provide on-campus resources that are available to student and faculty for effective execution of the designed programs.
3. Ensure availability of the faculty Coordinator and supporting staff to facilitate with resource persons visiting the college.

## VI. Duration of MOU:

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in Five years from the date of entering into this agreement. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended to another TWO years with mutual consent.



This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for an unlimited period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the Parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement. Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time during the term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.
