

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN GOVERNMENT CITY COLLEGE, HYDERABAD AND VALLIAPPA FOUNDATION, HYDERABAD

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is taken on 12-03-2020 by Government City College, Hyderabad and Valliappa Foundation, Hyderabad.

The parties share the goals of academically supporting activities and support Government City College in terms of encouraging Biochemistry pursuing students by providing academic guidance. The MOU formalizes the commitment of the parties to work together to provide educational support services to student and to improve the overall academic environment at Government City College, Hyderabad.

1. Objectives of the MOU:

This MOU is entered with the following specific objectives:

- a) To promote and enhance academic support to Government City College, Hyderabad in the form of conducting awareness programmes for the students with regard to Medical Coding and career prospects by **Valliappa Foundation, Hyderabad.**
- b) To provide necessary advice and suggestions for effective implementation of employable certificate courses in the Department of Biochemistry, Government City College, Hyderabad.
- c) To provide training cum placement guidance to the students of Biochemistry of Government City College and make them industry ready.
- d) To encourage the students in undertaking skill based employment programs at the **Valliappa Foundation, SR Nagar, Hyderabad.**
- e) Course content which have to be covered under this training course will be as per Annexure- I

2. Anatomy, Physiology

II. Proposed Modes of Collaboration:

The proposed MOU would facilitate in the form of providing career guidance to the students of Biochemistry, create awareness on future prospects in the stream of Medical Coding and upgrading the student knowledge on career placements.

III. Terms and Conditions

The academic assistance and support proposed to be extended by Valliappa Foundation, Hyderabad is purely on voluntary basis and there is no financial commitment in the form of payment of honorarium to the host institute i.e. Government City College, Hyderabad and vice-versa.

IV. The Role of College

The Government City College agrees to:

1. Encourage the students to opt for the employable certificate courses conducted by the Valliappa Foundation.
2. Ensure availability of the Faculty Coordinator and supporting staff to facilitate Counsel, guide, and mobilize the students for registration.

V. Duration of MOU:

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in Five years from the date of entering into this agreement. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended to another TWO years with mutual consent.

This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for a limited period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the Parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement. Either of the parties may terminate the Agreement at any time during the term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.
