
Introduction: Now-a-days E-Books are more accessible than printed books. There are so many sources for E-Books. We can read through so many google websites, apps and AI Books.

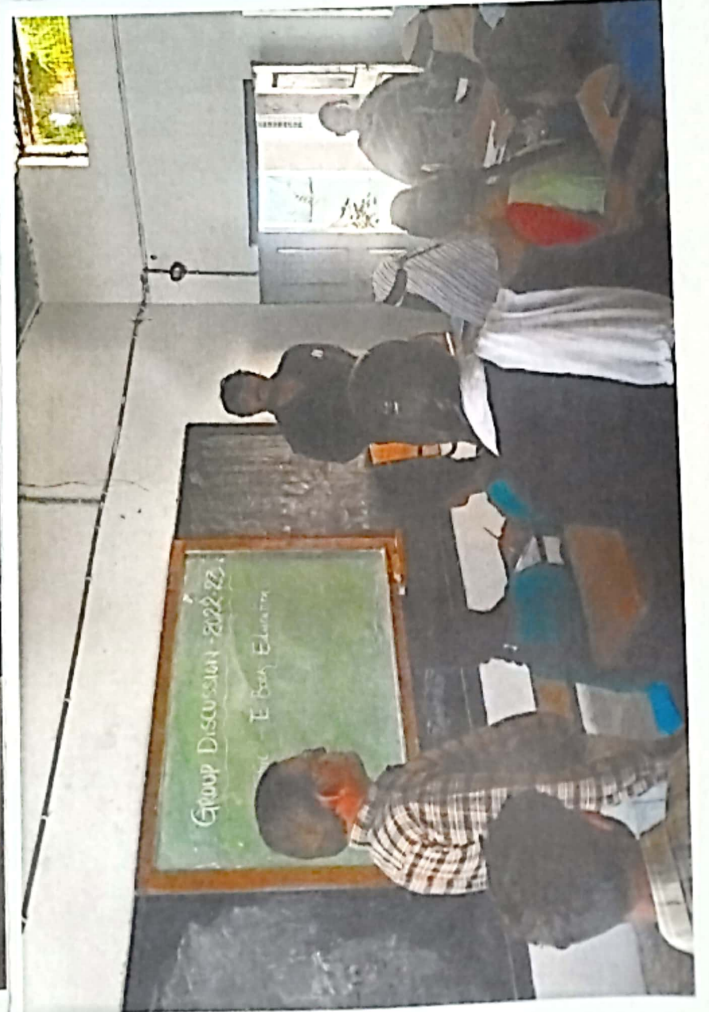
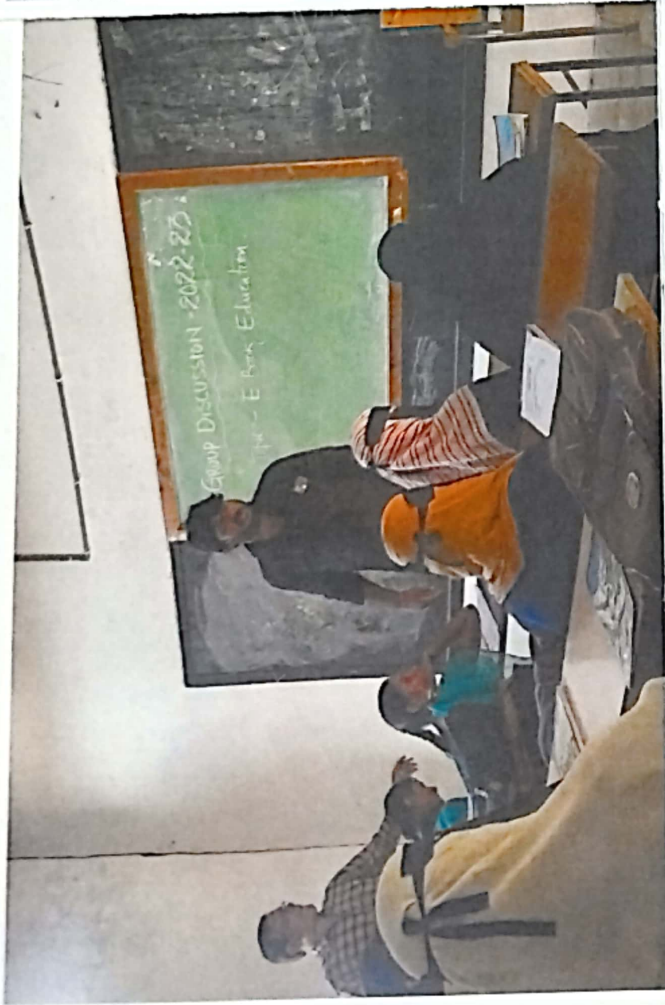
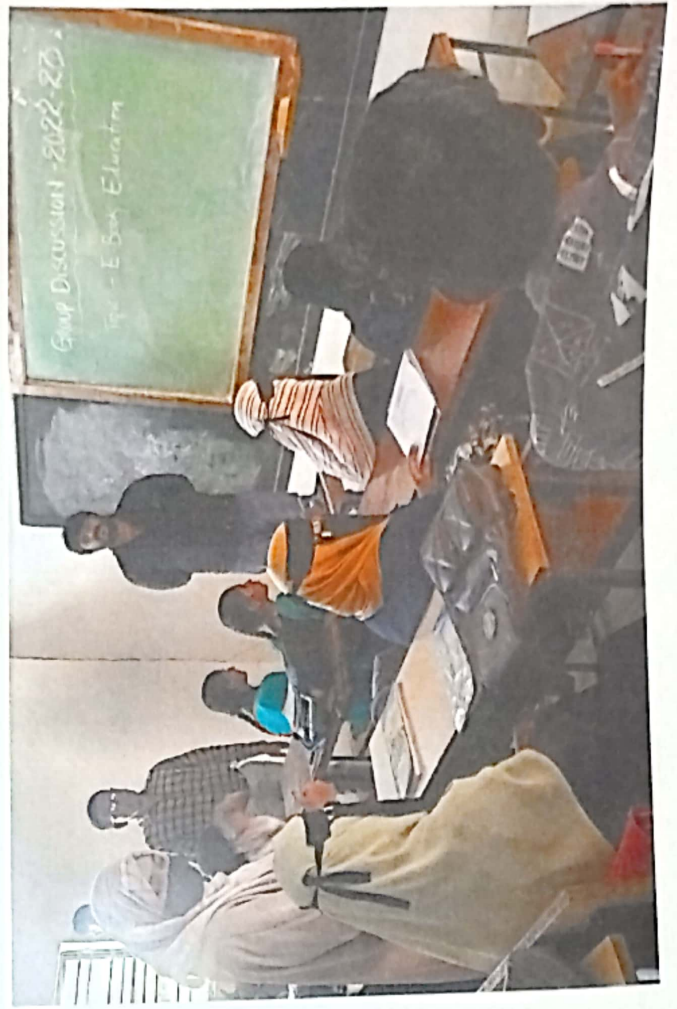
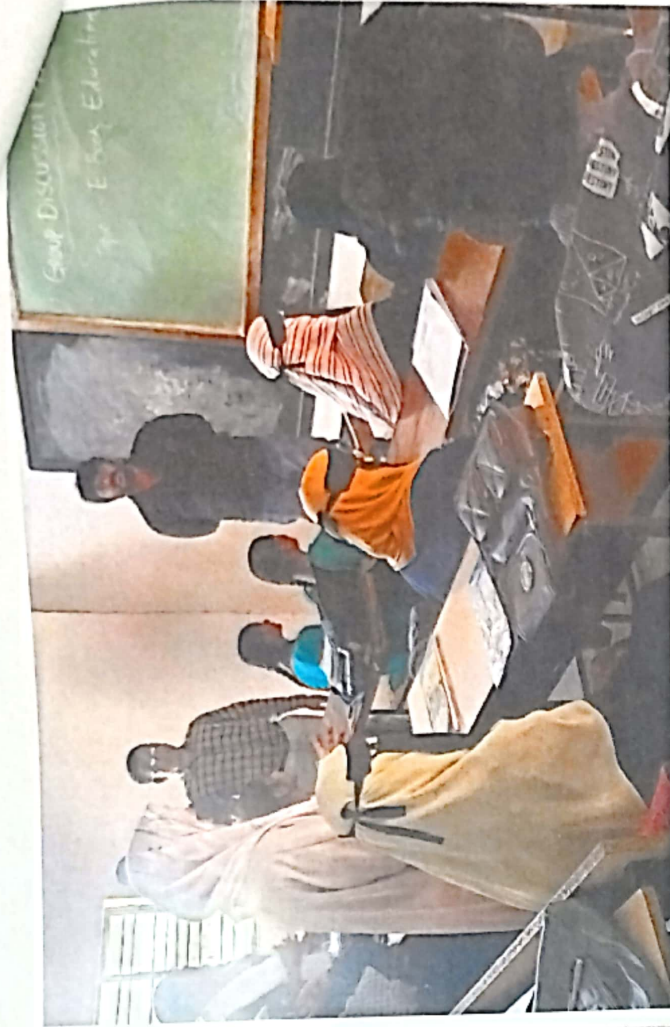
Opinion of the Students: Our opinion on this topic is student can't get distracted easily by E-Books than offline books. They are more prone to eye-defect by excessive screen time.
