Waste Management Policy

- ❖ The waste material generated in the college is segregated into solid and liquid.
- ❖ Among these liquid waste, solid waste and other hazardous waste are segregated on daily basis.
- ❖ All the science laboratories have been following standard waste management policies which are specific to their discipline. For instance, the e-waste material is disposed as per the e-waste policy of the college.
- ❖ The recycled waste such as leaves are to be dumped in the vermi-compost pit
- ❖ Paper shall be used sparingly and only when needed.

- ❖ Second side of used paper shall be used for the purpose of non-statutory documents.
- ❖ Sensitisation regarding waste management techniques will be undertaken periodically.
- ❖ Efforts will be made to reduce the generation of waste.
- ❖ MoUs with organisations, labs, Academic Institutions and other entities will be reached for qualitative improvement of service in terms of waste management.
