the professional world.

Assessment and Feedback Reforms: Ensuring fair and consistent assessment practices, providing timely feedback, and offering opportunities for self-assessment and improvement can contribute to a more effective learning environment.

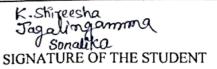




