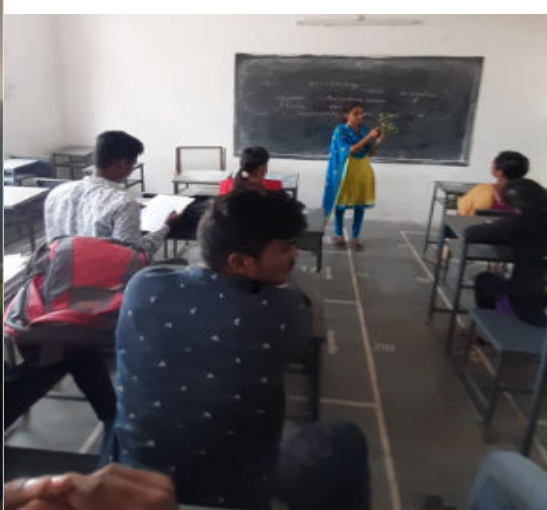
### Student Peer Learning

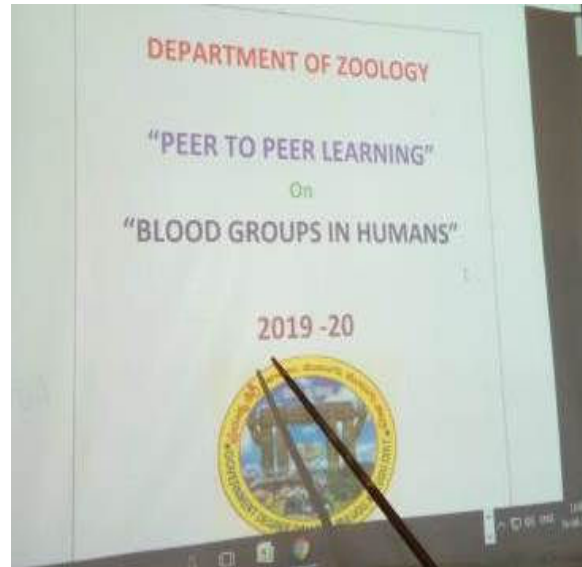

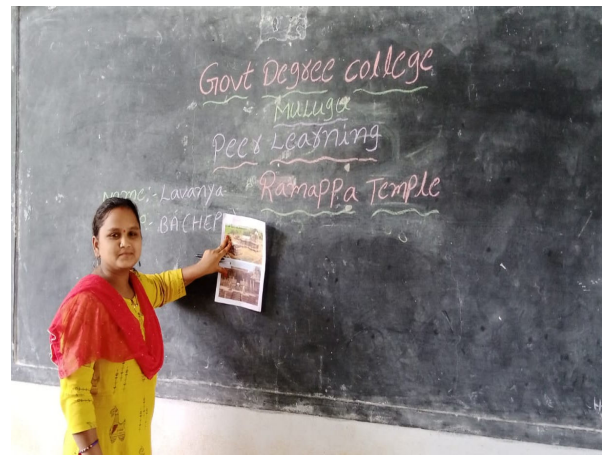

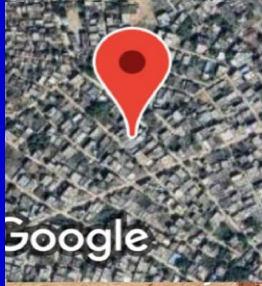

### TOPIC: CONTROL STRUCTURES IN JAVA

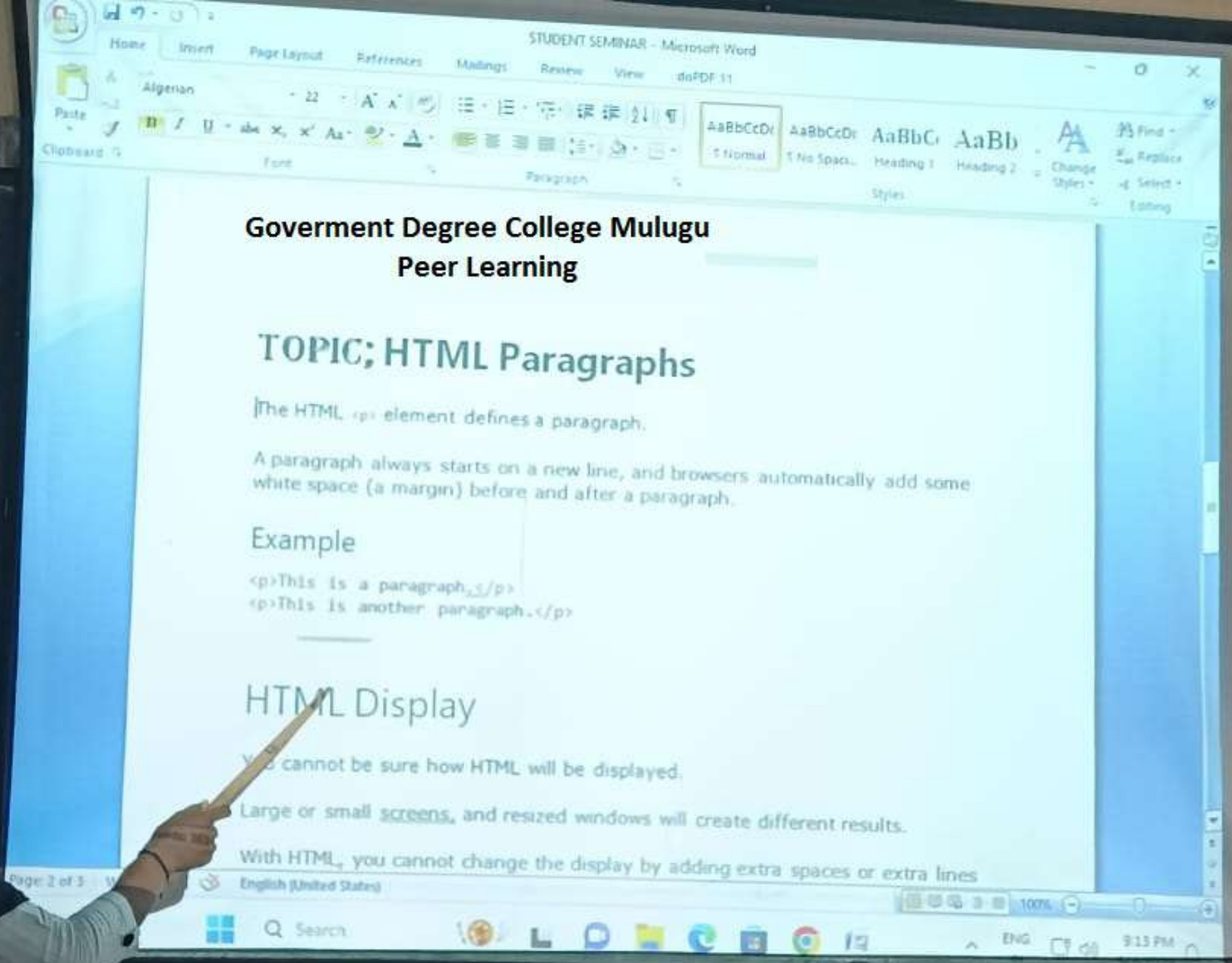
In the most basic sense, a program is a list of instructions. Control structures are programming blocks that can change the path we take through these instructions.

In the future, we'll explore control structures in Java.

There are three kinds of control structures:

- Conditional Structures, which we use for choosing between two or more paths. There are three types in Java: `if`, `if-else`, and `switch`.
- Loops that are used to iterate through multiple values/objects and repeatedly run specific code blocks. The basic loop types in Java are `for`, `while`, and `do-while`.
- Branching Statements, which are used to alter the flow of control in loops. There are two types in Java: `break` and `continue`.

## TOPIC; HTML Paragraphs

The HTML `<p>` element defines a paragraph.

A paragraph always starts on a new line, and browsers automatically add some white space (a margin) before and after a paragraph.

### Example
