- 1. A student who is detained due to shortage of attendance.
- 2. A student who is detained due to not passing in required number of papers.

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- 3. A student who has not continued next immediate semester after completing a semester because of personal or medical grounds.
- 4. A student who has not register for the examination but have attendance not less than 40% can take re admission in the same semester.
- 5. A student who has taken T.C. but returned back to join the course again.

Re admission in above cases is permissible within 3 years. In case of students taking T.c. approval of university is required. No readmission shall be done after the cutoff date (4\* week in 15 week semester).

### EVALUATION METHOD

### EVALUATION METHOD

- 1. Semester End Examination of Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) shall be conducted by the University and its marks shall be a part of SGPA and CGPA
- 2. AECC has 2 credits and will be evaluated for 50 marks: 10 marks internal assessment (10 MCQs and 10 FIBs of half mark each); 40 marks for Semester End exam (Section A: 10 marks - 2 short answers of 5 marks each, one from each unit. Section B: 30 marks - 2 long answers of 15 marks each, from each unit with internal choice).

(AECC - I Course: Environmental Studies - The framing of syllabi, question paper, paper setting, panel of examiners and other confidential related work will be taken up by the Chairperson, BoS in Environmental Studies and AECC - II Course: Gender Sensitization - the framing of syllabi, question paper, paper setting panel of examiners and other confidential related work will be taken up by the Chairperson, BoS in Sociology.)

- 3. Pattern of internal evaluation in UG Core and Elective papers (4 and 5 credit courses / papers) is 2 internal assessment tests of 15 marks each to be averaged and 1 assignment of 5 marks for a total of 20 marks. Each internal assessment question paper consists of 10 MCQs of 1/2 mark each; 10 FIBs of ½ mark each; 5 short answers of 1 mark each.
- 4 No assignments for any 3 credit core / elective course / paper.
- 5 NO INTERNAL EXAM for practical courses. Each 1 Credit Practical examination is evaluated at the end of the semaster for 25 marks. Evaluation by internal examiners for I, III & V Semesters and for II, IV & VI End Semesters by external examiners.

#### Improvement of grades

A student who has passed in theory paper can reappear once in that theory paper for improvement in grade. However, such improved grades will not be considered for the award of prize / medal, rank and distinction. A student will not be allowed to improve grade in internal assessment, project work and seminar.

## **DURATION OF COURSE**

A student should complete the course in three years from the date of admission.

If the syllabus is revised then a student re appearing in the exam is allowed according to old syllabus up to max of 5 years from the date of admission.

A student of six semester three year course must complete the course in max. 5 years.

### RULE FOR ATTENDENCE OF STUDENTS

Attendance of students should not be less than 75 % of the lectures delivered including the practical classes held.

A short fall in attendance between >=65% and <75% can be condoned on medical grounds on production of medical certificate and paying requisite fee.

A student can claim attendance for actual number of days (max. 20 days in a semester) for representing institute, state, university or nation in activities like NSS, NCC, SPORTS, ETC.

Section 'B' (80 marks) - 4 long question answer / essay type questions with internal choice (2 to be set per unit). Each question carries 15 marks.
  - II. 3 Credit Course / Paper (60 marks): Section "A" (15 marks) consists of 8 Short Answer Questions (at least two from each unit) out of which 5 questions are to be answered Each question carries 3 marks, Section 'B' (45 marks) - 3 long answer/essay type questions of 15 marks each with internal choice (2 to be set per unit)
