The concept of Telangana Skills & knowledge center (TSKC) was introduced by Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE) in the academic year 2016-17. Prior to this we had Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC) which was meant for few batches of students as it was optional and classes were conducted after the college hours. Whereas TSKC is integral part of curriculum and all the students are benefited.

CONCEPT

TSKC curriculum is designed to make the student self confident, self radiant and it makes them to enter into the society with self esteem. It makes the students to focus on various issues and challenges and helps them to acquire skills and knowledge apart from the regular bachelor degree. TSKC gives guidance to the students regarding the new emerging career opportunities available in the job market. It bridges the gap between the students and the skills required by the employers. The curriculum also encourages students as not only job seekers but also entrepreneurs.

OBJECTIVES

- ❖ *To make the student Self Confident and Self Reliable.*
- ❖ *To make the students to focus on various issues and challenges beyond their regular course.*
- ❖ *To make the students acquire skills and knowledge apart from regular degree course.*
- ❖ *To give guidance to the students regarding the new emerging career opportunities.*

To achieve these objectives, TSKC has taken up the following programmes.

1. Mentor – Mentee System:

Each Faculty member takes the responsibility of 20-40 students of one class. Every Mentor filed the student profile of every student and helped them to create individual email ID and submit the data online. They also take the responsibility of College attendance, Academic Performance, participation in Co-curricular activities like Student Seminars, Student Study Projects and Extracurricular activities like Sports, NSS, Haritha Haram and various academic club activities.

Mentors counsel the students regarding conduct, behavior, neatness, dress sense, punctuality, regularity etc. and try to make them socially responsible citizens.

2. TSKC Curriculum:

We have allotted weekly 4 periods for TSKC in regular time table and conducting the classes as per the time table covering the 5 components of TSKC Curriculum.

1	Communication Skills	<i>Speaking Skills, Writing Skills & Vocabulary building in both English and Mother Tongue.</i>
2	Technical Skills/ Computer Knowledge	<i>Basic knowledge of Computers, SBTET Typing Certificate, MS Office, Internet Browsing, MOOCs.</i>
3	Analytical & Aptitude Skills	<i>Logical Reasoning, Problem Solving, Creative Thinking and Arithmetic.</i>
4	Personality Development	<i>Knowing Oneself, Relationships, Right Knowledge</i>
5	Career Guidance & Job Preparedness	<i>Career Opportunities, Job Requirements and Job Preparedness, Grooming.</i>

For I year I Semester 24 periods of Communication Skills classes are handled by both English and Telugu Departments as it is bilingual. Career Guidance and Personality Development classes are engaged by Career Guidance Cell Members and AVPE Trainers. Analytical Skills, Reasoning, Aptitude and Technical Skills are handled by Full Time Mentor.

For II & III Year students, along with the above curriculum, Interview Skills, Entrepreneur Skills, Resume Writing etc. are taught. Mock Interviews, Role Play, Group Discussions are also conducted.

Tests are conducted according to the guidelines of CCE and marks are recorded. JAM Sessions, Self Introduction, explaining their Ambitions and Expectations in life are helping the students to get clarity about their goals.

It is a collaborative programme of the Department by making an MOU with UNDP and COIGN Consultant Pvt. Ltd. Out of 131 Colleges in the State Our College is one of the 50 selected Colleges under UNDP Project, i.e. "Creating Opportunity for Employment and Entrepreneurship for Women in India"

The activities under this programme are designed in such a way to

- ❖ Provide Information, Psychometric Profiling and Career Guidance to students.*
- ❖ Facilitate establishment of close linkages with the business/private sector to open up a range of Internship and Job Opportunities for Girls.*

- ❖ *Facilitate linkages with the Government and Private training providers to promote Entrepreneurship among students.*
- ❖ *Train and build capacity of college teachers as trainers and counselors for Career Guidance and Counseling of the students.*

The programme is carried in 3 steps.

- 1. Online Registration*
- 2. Psychometric Analysis through Online Assessments*
- 3. Counseling*
- 4. TOT(Training to Teachers for counseling and giving Career Guidance to the students)*

A total of 142 students registered, completed their Assessments and 102 students completed Counseling Sessions in the academic year 2017-18.

HR Personnel of the following companies visited the College and offered Internship to the students. Altogether 73 students have completed their Internship and nearly 48 students received Internship Letters. These students after the Degree final exams may be placed in different firms.
