ORDER:-

As Government have decided in principle to open New  
Government Degree Colleges during 1991-92, the Director of  
Collegiate Education has accordingly submitted his proposal  
to Government for sanction of Government Degree college at  
Zaheerabad, Medak District.

In the circumstances stated by the Director of Collegiate  
Education in his letter read above, Government hereby sanction  
for starting of Government Degree college at Zaheerabad, Medak  
District with one section in B.A. with 2 combinations:-

- i) Economics, History and Politics, and
- ii) Economics, Public Administration and Politics.

and one section in B.Com., Course in Telugu Medium and further  
one more section in Urdu Medium in B.Com., in addition to Telugu  
Medium subject to the following conditions:-

The sponsor of the College should deposit 50% of Corpus  
Fund of Rs.7.5 lakhs (i.e.) Rs.3.75 lakhs immediately in the Joint  
Account of Principal and the Regional Joint Director of Higher  
Education concerned and a Bank guarantee for the balance of Rs.  
3.75 lakhs should be furnished immediately. The sponsor should  
deposit the balance amount of Rs.3.75 lakhs in the Joint Account  
during the beginning of the IInd year of the courses (i.e.)  
1992-93, failing which the Bank Guarantee would be encashed.

2) The sponsors should also provide land of 2/4 acres if  
the student strength is upto one thousand and above one thousand  
respectively as envisaged in G.O.Ms.No.1623, Education, dated  
12.10.90.

3) A good building with furniture should be provided by  
the sponsor without any financial commitment to Government  
until permanent buildings are constructed by the Government.



3. Sanction is also accorded for creation of staff for Telugu Medium of B.A., and B.Com., courses Urdu Medium of B.Com., Section in respect of Government college, Zaheerabad:-

4. The above college shall be accommodated in the existing Government Junior college. The Principal of the Junior College may be allowed to receive the applications from the students for admission for admission into Degree course till alternative arrangements are made.

5. The Corpus Fund shall be deposited in the Joint Account of the Regional Joint Director of Higher Education concerned and Principal of Local Government Junior college for the present till a regular Principal of Government Degree college joins duty. Afterwards the Joint Account may be transferred in the Regional Joint Director of Higher Education concerned and the Principal of Government Degree College concerned.



6. The staff sanctioned above will draw the usual scales of pay and allowances and admissible under rules in force from time to time.

7. The Director of Collegiate Education is requested to see that wherever possible the surplus posts in the area for those appointed in supernumerary posts shall be absorbed in these new posts.

8. The University concerned of the sanctioned college is requested to extend the time limit for registration of applications from the students and also for their admissions into the college during 1991-92.

9. Sanction is accorded to incur an expenditure of Rs.4.50 lakhs (Rupees Four lakhs and fifty thousands only) (Rs.4.00 lakhs towards salaries and Rs.50,000/- thousand towards office expenses) for Government Degree College, Zaheerabad, Medak District.

10. As there is no provision available in the Budget, the expenditure sanctioned in Para 8 above shall be incurred in relaxation of treasury control order and debited to "2202 - General Education - 03 - University and Higher Education - M.H.103 - Government Colleges and Institutes - Schemes included in the Plan - S.H. (07) Government Degree Colleges for Men (Plan)" - 010 Salaries Rs.4.00 lakhs - 040 Office expenses Rs.0.50 lakhs and regularised by obtaining supplementary grant at the appropriate time.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (Finance EE) Department vide their U.O.No. D-91\_08/054-1394-EE/91, dated :13.8.91.
