- \* Growing kitchen garden; maintaining vermi-composting pits, construction of rain water harvesting structures in college.

## 2) BLUE CLUB :-

This club represents the water conservation in college and its idea should be transferred to the society by the students through the programmes.

It also brings awareness on rain water conservation & ground water recharge.

This club take care of water use & water harvesting, waste water reuse, testing of water quality & monitoring.

Small actions such as repairing leakages in pipelines, closing taps, pumps when not needed. Students should conduct survey of the quantity of water wasted from dripping taps everyday in college.

# 4) YELLOW CLUB :-


This club maintains the Conservation of Energy
