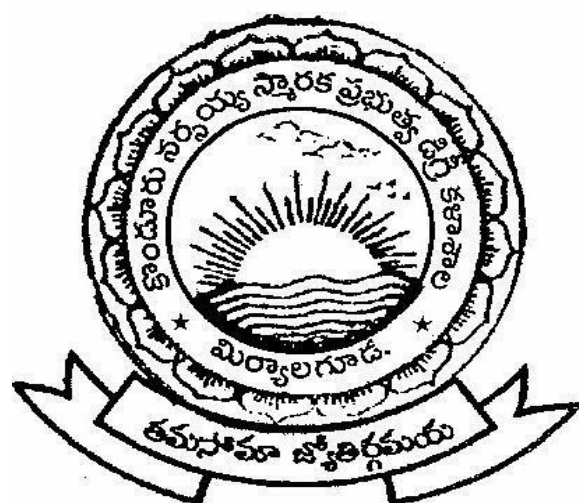
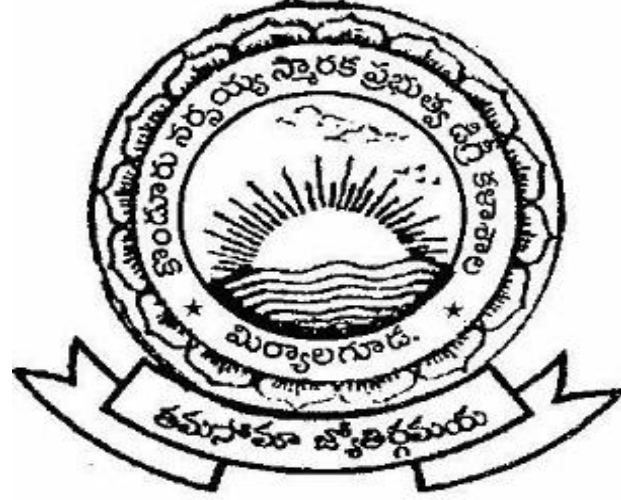

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT:

The Department of History is as old as KNMGDC itself it organized in 1981 along with the college as a constituent part of it. It offered students social with a contribution of EHP Group [Economics – History – Political Science] in the arts faculty.

The Department has 56 Hours work load with two sanctions posts and it continues to be still date Besides EHP group. E.H.PA EM / TM, H.P.PA TM/EM were introduced in 2017-18 Department of History offers, E.H.P, E.H.P.A, H.P.P.A EM / TM Courses to a strength of students 90% students belong to rural poor socially and economically backward classes.

The Department of History has evolved over all three years based on concentrated efforts of the members of the staff, focusing on the Indian history with a special references to the regional perfections. The course are designed to offer students a broad view of the world history as well as specialization in the history of Telangana with specific emphasis on it's cultural and socio economic conditions.

From 2014 – 2016 annual system was stated and from 2016 June on wards academic sem system started in EHP E.P.PA etc., courses.

From 2018 CBCS was introduced in the college. The department is providing all necessary facilities. The department library has two titles and the college library has adequate number of books. It is maintaining relevant paper clipping records.

Free coaching for PG Entrance is being given in summer and as many as 12 Students were selected for university education in the last 5 years.
