- Budget Estimation


Hence the Principals of Identified Colleges are requested to nominate their District Cultural & Literary Coordinator and Games & Sports Coordinator to attend the meeting on

13. **Light Music (Group):** Each team will be allowed 10 min to perform their dance (patriotic/ social message).
14. **Instrumental (Solo):** Each participant will be allotted 5 min to perform.
15. **Story Writing:** Each participant will be allotted 1 hour to write a story not exceeding 5 pages. The story should have a social message.
16. **Perception & Expression:** A painting or a photo collage will be shown to the participants. They have to interpret it and present their expression in 5 min.
17. **My Village & My Nation (Study Project):** The team of four students from each college has to prepare a study project about their village covering all the aspects or focusing on any one issues of that particular village. They will take the guidance from the concerned faculties and will be given 3 days for submitting the project report.
18. **Eureka (Science Exhibit):** To create scientific outlook and thought one science exhibit from each college/district is allowed for exhibition. They should be in innovative form. The participant/ participants have to demonstrate it.
19. **Poster Making:** Poster is made based on the given theme/topic. Students shall gather information; pictures etc. related to the theme and present it in the form of a poster. College & District level Competition College/ District Cultural Coordinator will decide the theme. For State Level Competition the theme will be communicated 3 days before.

Events- Rules & Regulations:

1. All the participants must be accompanied by the Coordinators/Team Managers/Responsible persons along with Identity Cards duly attested by the Principal.
2. All the participants should come with their own equipment for all events.
3. **One participant should participate in one event only.**
4. **Only one Team/Student is allowed to participate at district level competitions** and team/student winning first place at district level competitions will participate at state level competition. First two best teams/students will be awarded prizes. (1st & 2nd Prize)
5. For Essay writing & Elocution the topics will be announced an hour before the competition. For Essay Writing Competition white papers will be given by the organisers. Students should come with their writing pads.
6. **No night stay is allowed either Team Managers/Accompanists or students. Hence it is requested to make alternate arrangements.**
7. The state level competitions results will be placed in CCE's website after the completion of all the competitions.
8. The participants, accompanying Lecturers/Team Managers/Accompanists will be provided lunch, tea and snacks on the day of the competition by Host college
9. All the District & State Level Coordinators are requested to be in contact with the State Level Committee Members.

College Sports & Games coordinators shall submit the Winners list of the College level Winners list to the respective District coordinators by 29th November 2015.

District level coordinators shall submit the Winners list of the District level competitions to the State Level coordinators (respective games & sports) by 5th December 2015

State Level coordinators (respective games & sports) shall submit State Level Winners list to CCE by 10th December.

Rules and Guidelines:

- * An Athlete can participate a maximum of 2 games or 2 athletics events at College level
- * In athletics, two athletes (1st & 2nd) for each event from one college is permissible at District Level competitions. However at State level one athlete for each event from one District is permissible.
- * In Games category from each District only one team (Winner) will participate at State level competition.
- * For deciding the individual/team championship the points awarded as
 - 1st place - 5 points
 - 2nd place - 3 points
 - 3rd place - 1 point
- * In case of tie it will be resolved on the basis of no. of 1st places if tie continues the 2nd places will be considered. If tie continues declared as joint champions.
- * All the participants must show their College identity cards before the verification committee.
- * All the competitors should come with their own & necessary equipment.
- * If a player identified during the tournament as Misbehaving with the Official, or any in-disciplinary behavior, or Anti social activities such player will be debarred from the college, subsequently team will be disqualified and they are debarred to participate in Yuvatharagam tournaments for Three years.
- * All the District & State Level Coordinators are requested to be in contact with the State Level Committee Members.
- * **No night stay is allowed either Team Managers/Accompanists or students. Hence it is requested to make alternate arrangements.**
- * The state level competitions results will be placed in CCE's website after the completion of all the competitions.
- * The participants, accompanying Lecturers/Team Managers/Accompanists will be provided lunch, tea and snacks on the day of the competition by Host college
