- * All the Cluster & State Level Coordinators are requested to be in contact with the State Level Committee Members.
- * No night stay is allowed to either Team Managers/Accompanists or students. Hence it is requested to make required arrangements.
- * The state level competitions results will be placed in CCE's website after the completion of all the competitions.
- * The participants, accompanying Lecturers/Team Managers/Accompanists will be provided tea and snacks on the day of the competition by Host College. Lunch may be provided by the host college and the amount may be charged from the DA paid to the participant.
