ORDER:-

Sri Y. Yella Reddy, M.L.A., in his letter 1st read above has stated that on request of the pepple, parents and student organisations, the managerment of the college has come forward with a fullshape resolution to hand over the College assets worth around Rs.7.5 crores along with aided and un-aided staff to the Government. He has further stated that the College is a partially aided Degree College in the entire Revenue Division catering the Higher Educational needs of poor and needy students right from its inception i.e. 1984: The college is having permanent affiliation of Osmania University and receiving UGC developmental grants from 8th ; 'er, anwards. In 1991 the D.A. & B.Co.w. courses have been admitted into grant-in-aid. The B.Sc., courses which were started with Government permission from 1987 & 1988 onwards remained unaided. The staff selected as per G.O.Ms.No.12 Edn, dt.10-1-1992 are highly qualified and achieving very good results. But every year several students are discontinuing their studies in the middle for want of payment of fee in private college. Every year the drought is affecting a lot to the area. The present strength of the College is 873 including women 264. There is a dire need of the Government Degree College in the division. The S.L.Degree College, Narayanpet is a well established College and there won't be any burden to Government if it is taken over by the Government.

2. In the circumstances cited, Sri Y. Yella Reddy, M.L.A., Makhthal constituency, Mahabubnagar District has requested to consider the genuine appeal and help the needy students particularly young youth of the area.

3. Keeping in view of the long cherished desire of the students, parents and people in general of the area, the Management of Surya Laxmi Degree College has unanimously resolved to hand over the aided and unaided sections of the College with all its staff and assets to Government with immediate effect and requested the Government is take over the College as it has become highly difficult for the management to run the College with its meager resources. Sri P.Jithender Reddy, M.P., (Lok Sabha) in his letter 2nd read above has also made similar request to the Government.

4. The Director of Collegiate Education, A.P. Hyderabad in his letter 3rd read above while furnishing the detailed inspection report of the Joint Director, Collegiate Education, Hyderabad for take over of the said College and for acquisition of its assets, has requested the Government to issue necessary orders in the matter.

Joint Director, Collegiate Education, Hyderabad, and the report of the Director of Collegiate Education, A.P.Hyderabad and it is observed that the College may be taken over by the Government with all its assets excluding the un-aided posts, and liabilities. If any on the part of the aided Management may be completely discharged before taking over of the College. There will not be any additional financial commitment to the Government since the salaries to the aided posts are released by the Government, and the management of Surva Laxmi Degree College has given their willingness to mand over all the assets and properties to the Government, it is considered appropriate for taken over of the Surva Laxmi Degree College (Alded) by the Government.

6. Accordingly, the Government hereby direct that the Surya Laxmi Degree College (Alded), Narayanpet, Mahaboobnagar Dist., be taken over and transferred to the Government under Sub-section (1) of Section 60 of the A.P.Education Act, 1982 from the next financial year i.e., 1-4-2004 subject to the

following conditions:-

1. All assets of movable and immovable should be handed over to the Government without payment of any compensation.

2. Surplus staff (teaching and non teaching), shall be transferred to needy Government Degree Colleges, in the same zone.

3. All the teaching and non-teaching staff working in Surya Laxmi Degree College have to take last ranks after take-over and there will be no right to them to claim seniority in future.

4. There shall be no additional financial commitment to Government

elther now or in future.

5. No member in teaching and non-teaching in unaided posts shall be taken over.

6.The liabilities, if any, also be settled by the society, before the take-over of the college.

7. The Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A. P. Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly and to issue a certificate confirming the aided posts and the names of the present incumbent including his/her date of birth, present pay and updating their service record before take over the Degree College.

8. This Order issues with the concurrence of Finance (Expr.HE) Department, vide their U.O.No.32692/681/Expr.HE/2003, dt.22-12-2003.
