Students have taken their exam where the paper included 5 fill in the blanks carrying 10 marks, 5 multiple choice questions carrying 10 marks and 10 marks for Abbreviations, and 10 one word answer questions carrying 20 marks. out of 30 students 28 students have taken their exam and almost all the students have passed .

COURSE OUTCOMES

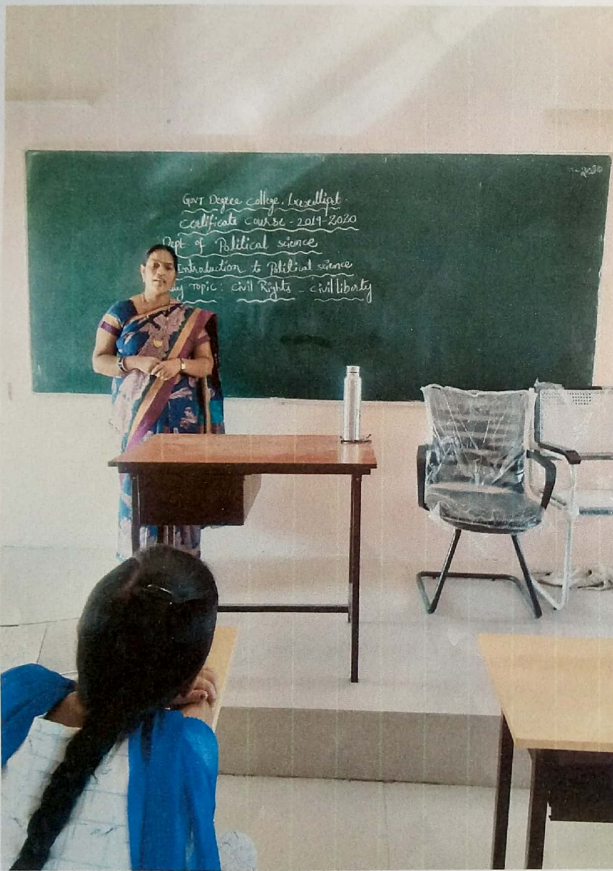
