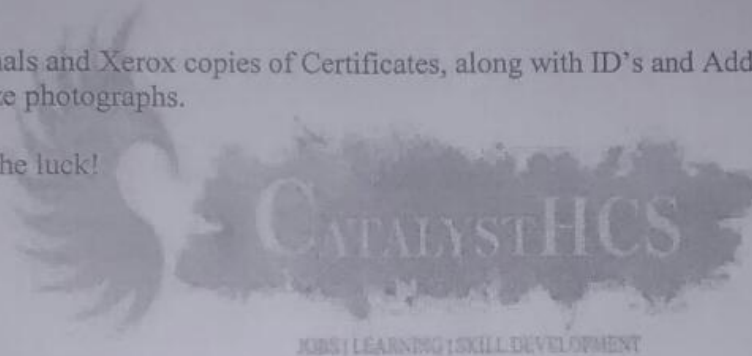

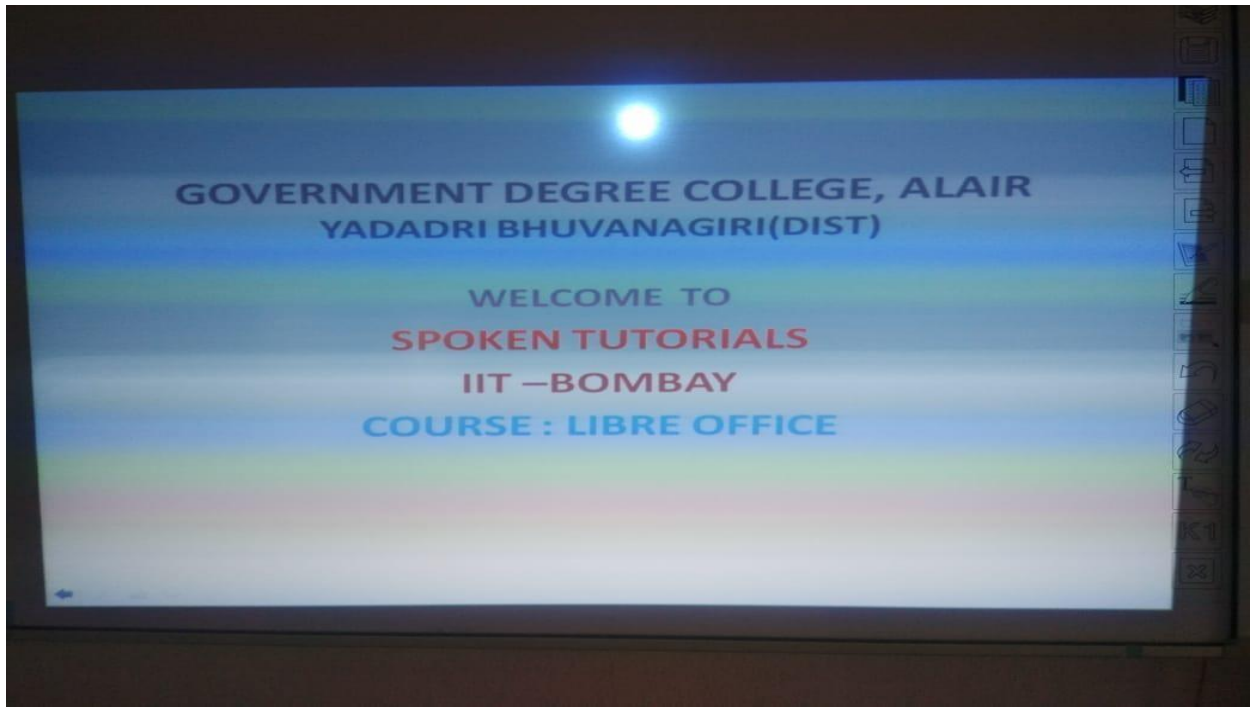

Event: Industrial visit

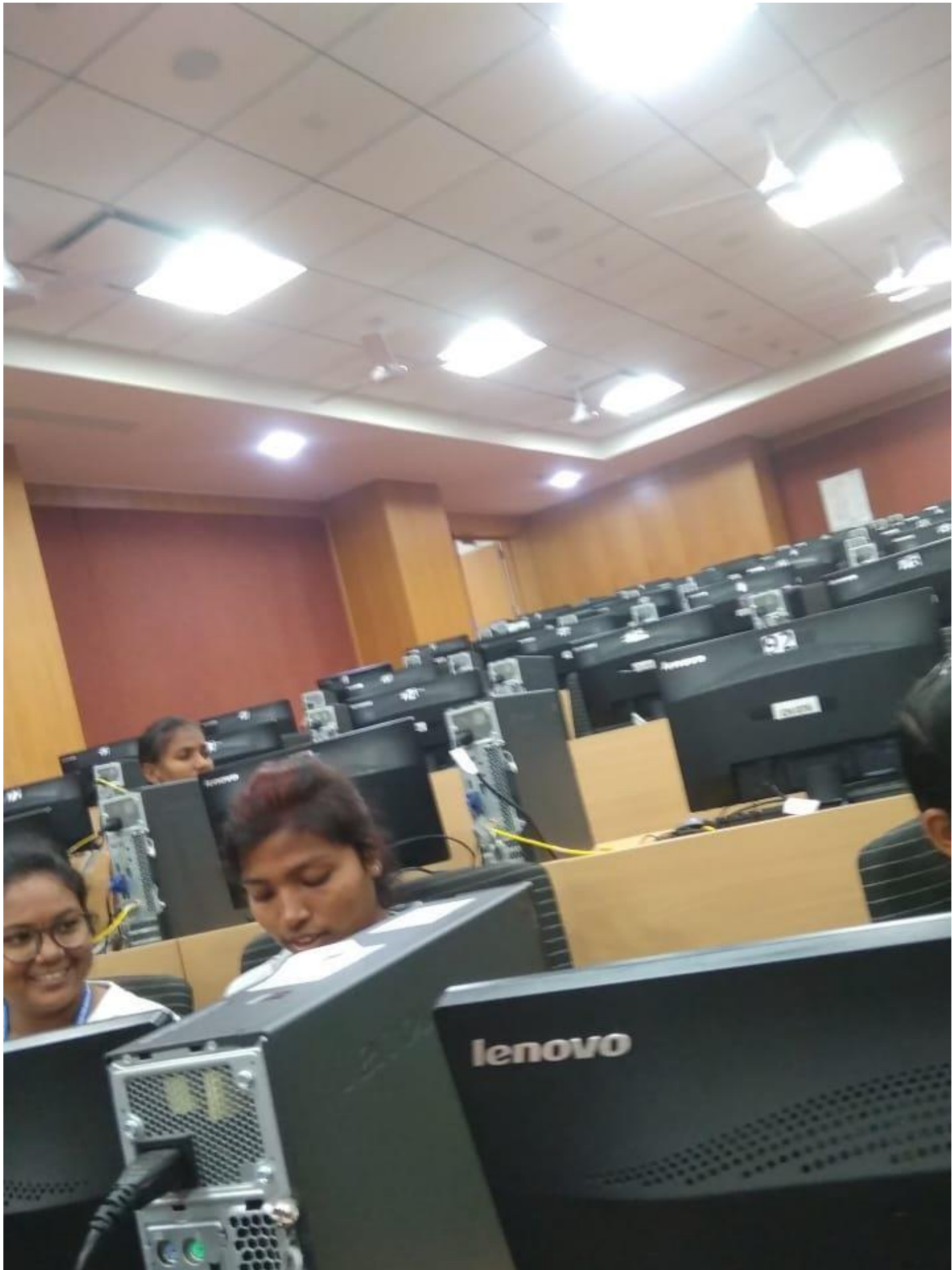
