The topic of the seminar suggested by the dept of sciences of the college is approved by the TAS as it is the need of the hour to have serious discussions on environmental issues and to make strategies to save our environment from various hazardsand to give our present and future generations a pollution free environment. Sub themes for the seminar topic were provided for the speakers and paper presenters to cover the main topic. The brocher of the seminar was released by the College Principal Dr Bi Bi Zainab and Palamuru University Vice Chancellor Prof B Raja Ratnam. The brocher was circulated to all the Universities and colleges across the state and other states.

Dr Ch Mohan Rao former director CCMB was the chief guest of the seminar. Eminent Scientists and environmentalists Prof Katta Narsimha Reddy former Vice Chancellor Prof K Purshotham Reddy Prof G Bhanu Prakash Reddy and Prof K Girija Registrar Palamuru University were the guests of honor. Prof P Pavan Kumar COE Palamuru University dist coordinator TAS and Dr B Rupavani Asst Prof Degree and PG

College Mahabubnagar coordinated for the seminar. Dr B B Zainab Principal of the College presided over the inaugural session of the seminar. Amena Mumtaz Jahan HOD Dept of Botany was the convener of the seminar and G Swathi HOD Chemistry Dr Vijayalaxmi HOD Mathematics and Surayya Jabeen HOD Physics were co conveners of the seminar.

In the inaugural Session Dr B Rupavani Asst Prof Degree and PG College Mahabubnagar in her introductory speech said that man is always invented things for his comfort but in search of comfort he is disturbing the balance of our environment now it is the need of the hour to come with natural way of life style and we have to avoid things which are harming our environment. Reddy Prof G Bhanu Prakash Reddy Regional Coordinator of TAS in his inaugural address said that if we protect the nature the nature will protect us. He emphasized on the students to opt science as a career so they can work for the protection of environment. He expressed the need to minimize the use of plastics and Ro Water and to plant trees on larger ground. He said that every one should plant and save ten trees to improve pollution. Prof K Purshotham Reddy eminent environmentalist and retired prof of Osmania University presented a world view on environmental protection and discussed the 15 point formula to protect our environment he said that we are on the verge of global environmental crisis and we have to work unitedly to save our planet. Mr Nagendar Swamy CPDC Member of the college said that the growing consumerism is the major cause of pollution. It is our duty to plant and protect the trees. Prof Katta Narsimha Reddy noted scientist said that pollution problem has emerged a lot in recent years due to industrial revolution and it is difficult to control the pollution. He said that the govts and public should come forward to upgrade our environment then only we can confront this problem. Dr Pratibha CPDC member said that it is time to save the nature and follow the path of reduce reuse and recycle. Dr Bi Bi Zainab welcomed the gathering and in her message she quoted the famous quote of Mahatma Gandhi that Earth provides enough to satisfy every man's needs, but not every man's greed. Dr C H Mohan Rao in his key note address presented the causes of Global Warming rise in Co₂ and deforestation. He also suggested to increase plantation to confront the problems of Global Warming. He said that the growing population of the world is also causing problem he suggested that have less children but more plants.

Empowerment is the process of increasing the capacity of individuals or groups to make choices and to transform those choices into desired actions and outcomes. Central to this process are actions which both build individual and collective assets, and improve the efficiency and fairness of

the organizational and institutional context which they govern the use of these assets. Women's role in the political process has virtually remained unchanged since independence. The 73rd and 74th Constitutional Amendments Act, 1992, accorded constitutional status to local bodies and thus also paved the way for empowerment of women through reservations. The commitment to political empowerment must be supplemented by a new conceptualization of women's role in the economy of India. There should be a remedy for each problem. It should be followed by comprehensive empowerment policies and programmes.
