Student Result Management System

1. **Objective of the Practice:** To find the academic progress of a student at a single entry

2. **Need Addressed and the Context:** The intake of the Government Degree College for Women, Nalgonda is increased three folds in the recent years and there are 2174 students in the year 2019-20. As the college adopted C.B.C.S, the results of 6 semesters in each year in various combinations used to be recorded manually. Departments of the college used to get the results of their subjects from University site and record in their registers. Departments used to analyze the results subject wise and the same were consolidated. But it was very difficult to find the overall result of a student at a glance until final memorandum of marks is issued by the University after passing all the subjects. To address the problem it is decided to have a platform, which can give the status of all university results of a student at a glance with a single entry.

3. **The Practice:** As the required result management system costs a lot if any external agency is involved, it is decided to prepare an excel program compiling all the data available using the interested Mathematics & computer science students and Mathematics & computer science faculty. Data from all the departments was collected and compiled and an excel program is prepared under the guidance of IQAC Coordinator, to get the results of a student pertaining to all semesters glance with a single entry of their Hall Ticket.

4. **Evidence of Success:** With the above result management system prepared in the college, it is now very easy to get the consolidated result of any student instantly which in turn enables to identify student's backlog subjects at the examination branch. The same Data is shared to the mentors for their assessment and further interaction with their mentees and guiding the student to undergo the remedial coaching. It has now become a handy tool to monitor the student progression in the university examinations. Students involved in this project gained hands on experience as the data is very huge and has live applications.

5. **Resources:** Examination results compiled by the Departments, University website and Semester Grade reports of the University are used in this Student Result Management System. Mathematics & Computer Science faculty & students are actively involved in this project.
