At the outset, the Chairperson has greeted the members and initiated the Agenda for discussion. The Convener and Identified College Principal of Govt. Degree & PG College, Narsampet Lt. Dr. B. Chandramouli submitted the report of items of Agenda and Action Taken Report of previous DCEDRC Meeting to the Chairperson.

- The Chairperson assessed the results of CBCS May/June 2019 Semester Results of all three colleges and enquired enrolment 2019-20.
- The Convener submitted the results GDC Narsampet – 63.49%; GDC Parkal 64% and GDC Wardhannapet 60%.
- The enrolment of the three colleges is GDC Narsampet – 70, GDC Parkal 74 and GDC Wardhannapet 62.

- The Chairperson suggested to discuss among the colleges regarding implementation of Skill Development programmes and to consider about the feasibility of DRDA and to contact the District Employment Officer.
- The Chairperson suggested to take particular activity of Skill based programme and follow up for desired outcomes.
- It is submitted that Land and permanent Building is required for GDC Parkal and GDC Wardhannapet.
- It is submitted that GDC Wardhannapet has been shifted to private building on rent basis w.e.f. 01-07-2019. The land issue of GDC Parkal is discussed.
- The Chairperson suggested to find possible solutions with available resources.
- It is proposed to conduct Skill enhancement programmes such as TALLY, Soft Skills, Communication Skills, etc to the students.
- The Convenor DCEDRC & Principal ID College Dr. B. Chandramouli expressed his gratitude to the District Collector & Magistrate for handing over the cheque of Rs.55000/- towards purchase of Computer tables and chairs for Digital Library to GDC Narsampet.
- Infrastructure is required for all the three colleges –GDC Parkal and GDC Wardhannapet require 10 computers and 50 dual desks. GDC Narsampet requires completion of Compound wall and construction of Girls Hostel.
- The issue to Toilets is raised by the Principal GDC Parkal.
- ~~Minimum Requirements of colleges which do not have drinking water and toilets facilities are to be procured.~~
- The Chairperson asked to focus on the career of the students and suggested to conduct awareness of Self-employment programmes.
- She has asked to change the mindset and work according to the needs of the system for development of institutions.
- It is unanimously resolved to follow the suggestions and directions of the District Collector and implement the Action Plan 2019-20 accordingly.
