Report on Cashless/ E-transaction Awareness programme:

A NCC Team of 15 members, Lt M. Vigneshwar, ANO and 14 Cadets, of 162/31 T Bn NCC of N.G. College, Nalgonda went to Charlapally Village in Nalgonda District at 7.30AM on 12th January 2017.
