About the Department

The college was started in the premises of the Quilla Jail on the auspicious day of 12th June 1956. It is a great fortune to have Sri P.L.N. Sharma, the doyen of the Osmania University Teachers Association member, as its founder and Principal, who built up an excellent image to the institution during his tenure. This college appeared for assessment and accreditation from NAAC in 2004,2011 and 2018. This college recognised as “College with Potential of Excellence (CPE)” by University Grants Commission, New Delhi, which is a feather in the cap of the college.

The Department of Hindi of this college was established in the year 1956. The first in-charge of the department at the time of inception was Sri. Surya Deva Shastri, and at present Ambekar Babu Rao, Sri Surya Deva shastri who served with keen interest and enthusiasm for the establishment and improvement of the Department. Later Sri Vidhyadhar Panday joined department in the year 1957. He was an eminent Scholar who contributed a lot for spreading message of the importance of the Language. Sri D.V. Subba Rao who worked from 1962 to 1986, contributed a lot for the development of the department. He participated many times in reciting not only Hindi, but also Telugu poetry.

Sri. Chavakula Narasimha Murthy joined the Department in the year 1964 and worked till 1968. He was founder of Hindi premi mandali and taught Hindi lessons regularly for a period of five years in all india Radio, Hyderabad, which benefited the people of Telugu very much in learning the National language. After his transfer Sri Tulaja Prasad joined the Department along with Sri D.V. Subbarao. Sri Subbarao joined in 1978. Dr. Shobhanath Singh who worked from 1982 to 1984, contributed a lot to the Department. Sri Dharampal Peehal joined in 1984, Sri Ajith Kumar, Sri Chandradev Sharma, Sri Narasimha Chary, Sri Sk. Harooi were there in the Department, who organized various academic activities in the Department, which added beauty.

Sri G. Ravi kiran and Dr. Shobhanath Singh joined the Department in the year 1996 and 2001 respectively. Since, then numbers of activities have been taken up with co-operation and Zeal.

Sri P. Gangadhar joined in the Department in 2005 in the place of Dr. Shobhanath Singh. After transfer of G. Ravi kiran in 2006, Sri Rajpal, Contract Lecturer joined in the Department. He worked in the Department one year. After that Sri Ramachander joined in the Department. Sri P. Gangadhar and M. Ramachandra since then with their active participation, programmes such as essay writing, elocution, Quiz, poetry writing, General knowledge competitions were successfully conducted. After transfer of M. Ramachandram in 2010 Smt. G. Sujatha joined in the Department as a guest faculty.

Sri. P. Gangadhar, the incharge of the Department has been a source of inspiration to the community of the students and Lecturers as well in their creative writing for the college magazine. The Department Organizes “HINDI DIVAS” every year. On that auspicious day, programmes like reciting poetry and library Quiz, Essay writing and elocution competitions are taken up for the benefit of the students and in this respect, the prizes distributed among successful winners.

They organized the National Seminar First time in the history of Hindi Department on 26-02-2013 and many guest lectures. Sri P. Gangadhar retired in September, 2013. As per the proceeding of the Principal Sri S. Limba Goud Sri. Gulam Mustafa have taken the incharge ship of the Hindi Department. Along with him his wife Dr. Mrs. Naseera Naqueen also joined in the Dept in the year 2013 and worked upto 2018. After that the Gulam Mustaffa Transferred from this College to GDC, Armoor.

At present Sri. Ambekar Babu Rao is the Head Department of Hindi. Sri Ambekar Babu Rao joined in the Department by General Transfers on 30th June 2018. Sri Ambekar babu Rao have taken the incharge ship of the NCC as a Associated NCC Officer (ANO) from 2018 to till date and Smt Dr. D. Hemalatha Served the department very actively with better understanding. Dr. D. Hemalatha is the Co-Ordinator of W.E.C.

Hindi is imparted to the students of Telugu and English medium of under graduate students as second Language. The students are evaluated in paper I, II, III and IV at the end of semesters I, II, III and IV. The results of the department are very much encouraging and consistent. This department works for students to excel in the language skills by sensitizing them to participate in various cultural and literary activities like Essay Writing, Elocution, Poetry Reciting, Quiz, Story Writing, Poetry Writing, Singing, Classical and Folk dance, Mono Action etc., Organised at the college level and also at district level, by the different non-government and government agencies on occasion of the important days such as “**Hindi Divas** ” on 14th September.

The department pays keen attention on individual performance in the class room to acquire command over the language and literature. It also takes care in promoting skills among the students to develop Literary and Communication skills. The department is strictly adhered to the academic schedule of the Telangana University; apart from the syllabus completion the Department maintains all academic records.
