The department of Telugu of Government Degree College in Hayathnagar, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana planned to organize a literary forum on the works of the recipients of ‘Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar’ from the year 2015 to 2019 as all the recipients of this national level prestigious award in Telugu category was secured by the young and upcoming literary personalities from the state. The department felt that this programme will lay a foundation for tapping the creative abilities among the young graduates of the college. The programme would boost the innate talents in the students of the college. The idea was discussed among the Principal and members of staff. All were of the view that this will definitely be a wonderful programme.

A detailed proposal with details of programme schedule, guests, resource persons and agenda was submitted to the Kendra Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi for assistance. The Kendra Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi responded positively and accorded permission to organize the programme. The akademi also consented to co-host the programme. Accordingly, the programme was organized on 25th September, 2019 instead of 12th September 2019 from 2.00 P.M to 5.30 P.M in the Kaloji Seminar Hall in the college.

The literary forum titled ‘Yuva Sahithi’ was presided over by the Principal of the college, Dr. J. Raja Ram. Welcoming the chief guest, recipients of the Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar the principal hoped that the literary forum will be a learning and motivating platform for the students and members of faculty. He congratulated the Department of Telugu for the initiative. The chief guest of the forum was the famous Telugu poet, recipient of the Kendra Sahitya Akademi Award in the year 1990 and presently Convener, Sahitya Akademi, Telugu Sri K Siva Reddy. Addressing the participants of the forum Sri Siva Reddy said that literature helps in moulding the overall personality of an individual. He also laid emphasis on enhancing the creative abilities of the students along with their regular academics.

The ‘Yuva Sahithi’ then continued as per the regular agenda. The works of the recipients of ‘Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar’ from the year 2015 to 2019 were analyzed critically in the form of paper presentations by reputed literary personalities and academicians. The recipient of the puraskar in 2015 was Dr. Pasnuri Ravinder for his collection of stories, ‘Out of Coverage Area’. Sri Sangishetty Srinivas, Assistant Professor, Government Degree College, Malkajgiri was scheduled to present a paper analyzing the work, ‘Out of Coverage Area’, but due to his personal emergencies could not attend the programme. Instead, Dr. Veldandi Sridhar, Assistant

Professor of Telugu, Government Degree College, Hayathnagar presented his paper on the work. The paper focused on how the forms of oppression on the socially marginalized changed but the oppression has not stopped. 'The SC, ST, Minorities still continue to live out of coverage area of development even to this day is the central idea of Pasunuri's award winning work. Dr. Pasunuri Ravinder gave his response to the paper presentation made by Dr. Veldandi Sridhar.

Ms. Chaitanya Pingali won the 'Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar' for her work 'Chittagong Viplava Vanithalu' in the year 2016. Dr. Yakoob, Member, Sahitya Akademi, Advisory Board, Telugu category presented a paper on this work. The paper presenter made a detailed analysis on the work of Ms. Chaitanya that details upon the freedom struggle undertaken by the brave young women from Chittagong. This part of the history has never come into lime light until this work. Ms. Chaitanya Pingali who was present during the programme responded to the presentation.

'Maatala Madugu' written by Mercy Margaret bagged the 'Kendra Sahithya Akademi Yuva Puraskar' in the year 2017 in Telugu category. Renowned literary critic and writer, Sri M Narayana Sharma presented a paper on this work. The collection of poems highlights the pain, trauma and suffering of an oppressed community. The poems helped to vent out these feelings both sensitively and strongly. Ms. Mercy Margaret, in her response, encouraged the young graduating students to pour out their feelings and the situations around them in any kind of art form.

Dr. S. Raghu, Assistant Professor, Osmania University, Hyderabad presented a paper on 'Aaku Kadalanchota' written by Bala Sudhakara Mouli – the recipient of 'Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar' in the year 2018 in Telugu category. The collection of poetry showcases 62 poems among which 5 poems are translations from different languages. The contemporary political issues like Bauxite mining, attacks on Muslim writers and the murder of human rights activist, Kalburgi.

The last paper was presented by Dr. Pathipaka Mohan, Assistant Editor of Telugu, National Book Trust, Government of India on the work of Dr. Gaddam Mohan Rao titled 'Kongavaalu Katthi'. This particular work helped him bag the 'Kendra Sahithya Akademi Yuva Puraskar' in the year 2019 in Telugu category. The work encompasses the life of the marginalized Chindu community in the madiga (SC) community that was treated as outcastes. Dr. Gaddam Mohan Rao, in his response, appreciated the efforts taken by the paper presenter that gave a detailed account of his book.

At the beginning of the programme while Sri. Ch. Rakesh Bhavani, Co-convener of the programme and Assistant Professor, Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Hayathnagar invited the dignitaries onto the dais, the Head, Department of Telugu, Sri K. Suresh who is also the co-convener of the programme introduced the chief guest, recipients of the 'Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar' from the year 2015 to 2019 and the resource persons

for the literary forum who presented their papers. Dr. Veldandi Sridhar, Organizing Secretary of the 'Yuva Sahithi' literary forum coordinated the entire programme efficiently that drew accolades from all quarters. Sri.
