
HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT


Conclusion of the study:

<u>**Hypothesis 1**</u>-Demonetisation created hardships to the rural people-proved correct.

Hypothesis 2-Rural people are supporting Demonetization-this was disproved-27% of the rural people supported Demonetization where as 73% of them rejected it.

<u>Hypothesis 3</u>-Demonetisation could not cause any additional benefit to the rural people-99.5% of the Rural people agreed to this hypothesis.




























Field Trip:
