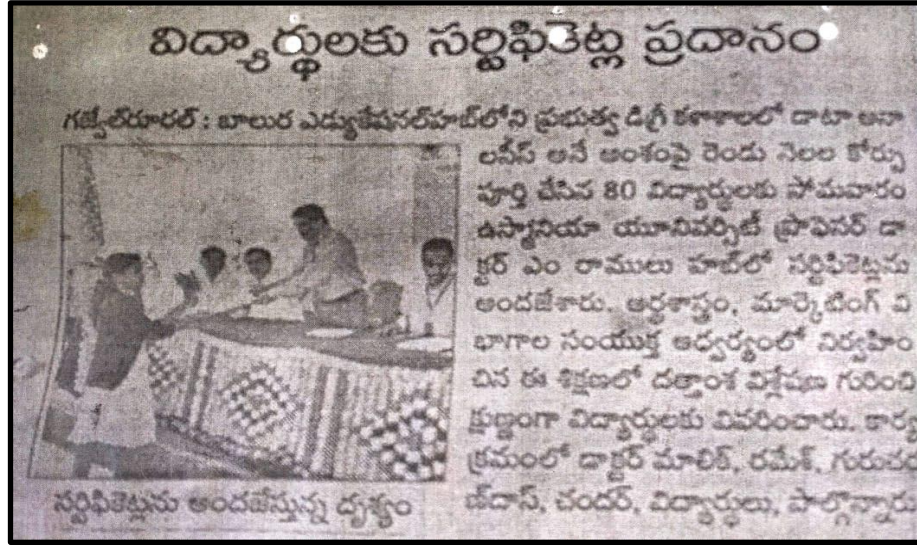


The Department of Economics, as the incharge of social service unit celebrated World Population Day in the campus, involving all the students and making them aware of the issues related to over population.

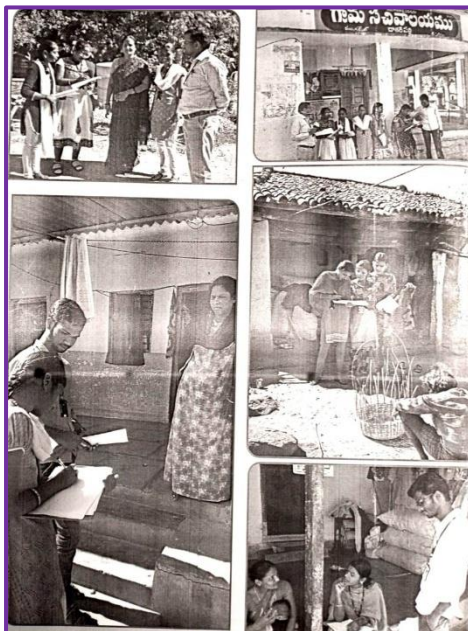
Conclusion of the study:

Hypothesis 2-Rural people are supporting Demonetization-this was disproved-27% of the rural people supported Demonetization where as 73% of them rejected it.

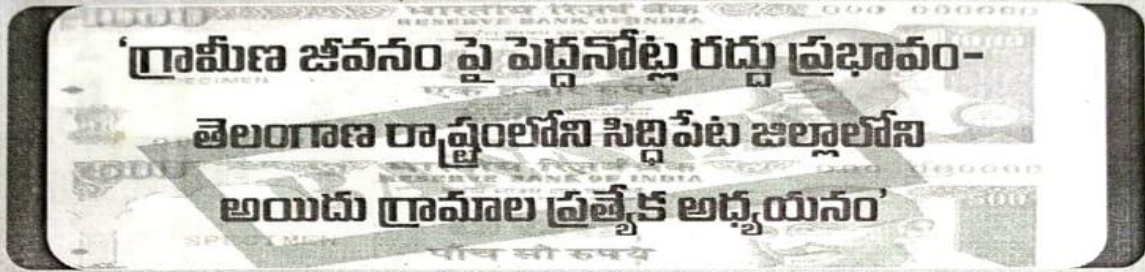
Hypothesis 3-Demonetisation could not cause any additional benefit to the rural people-99.5% of the Rural people agreed to this hypothesis.

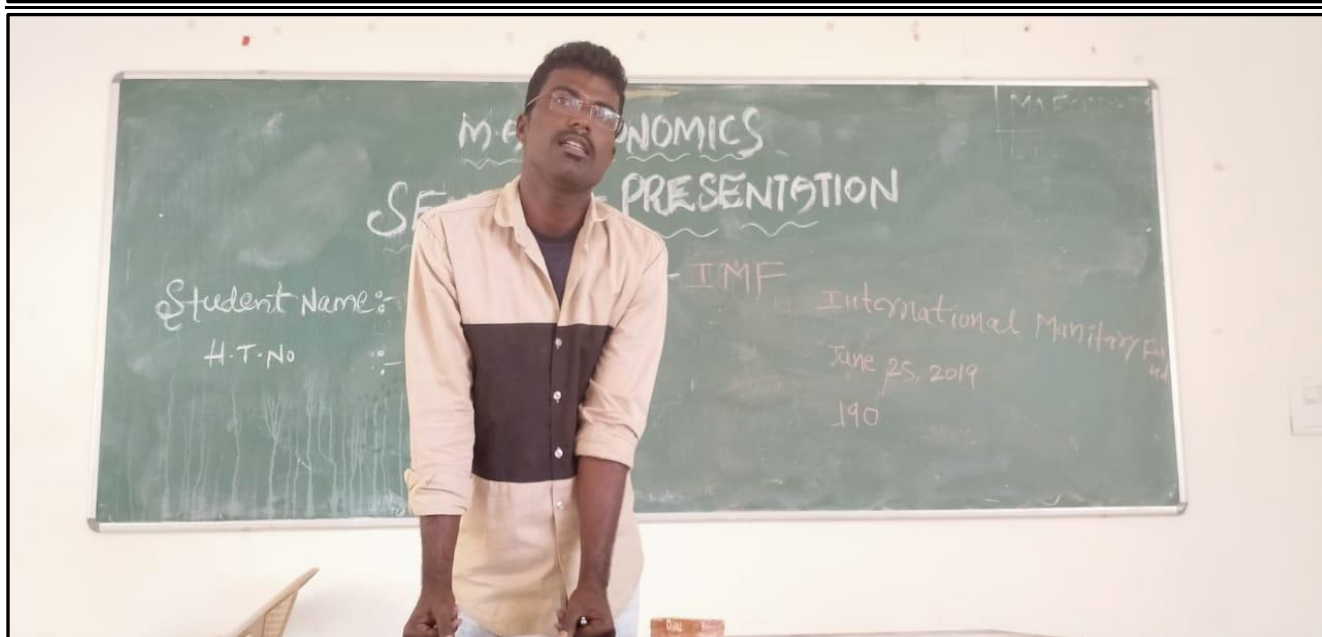
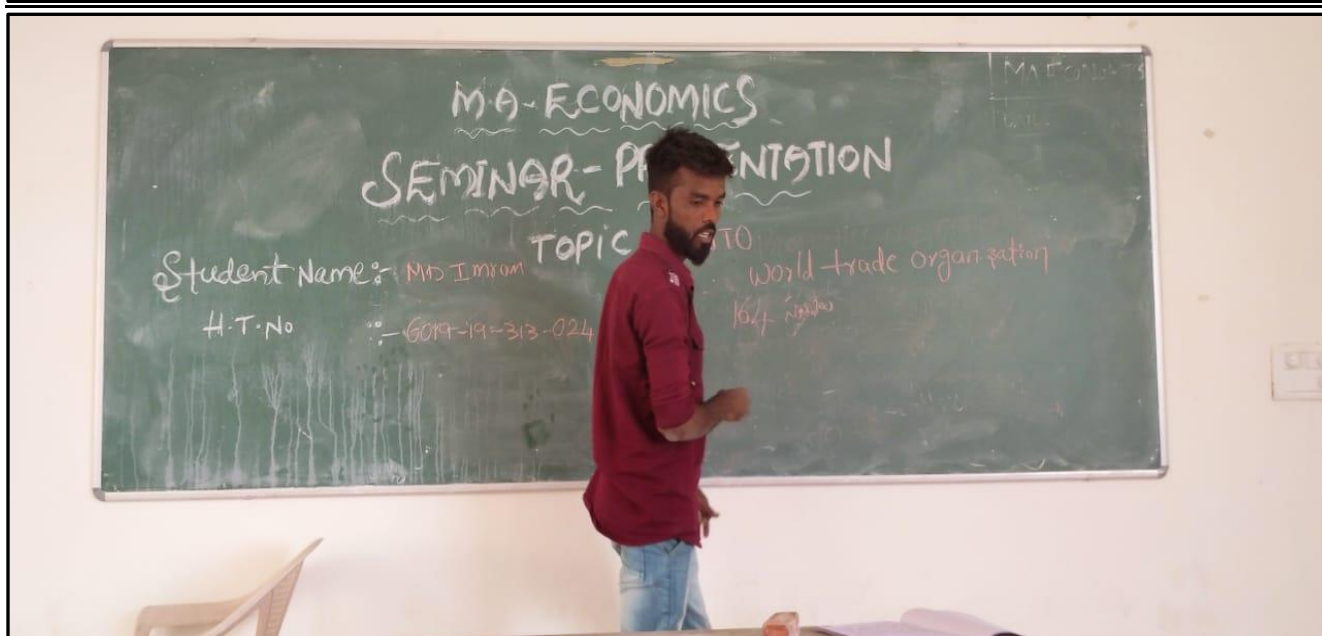


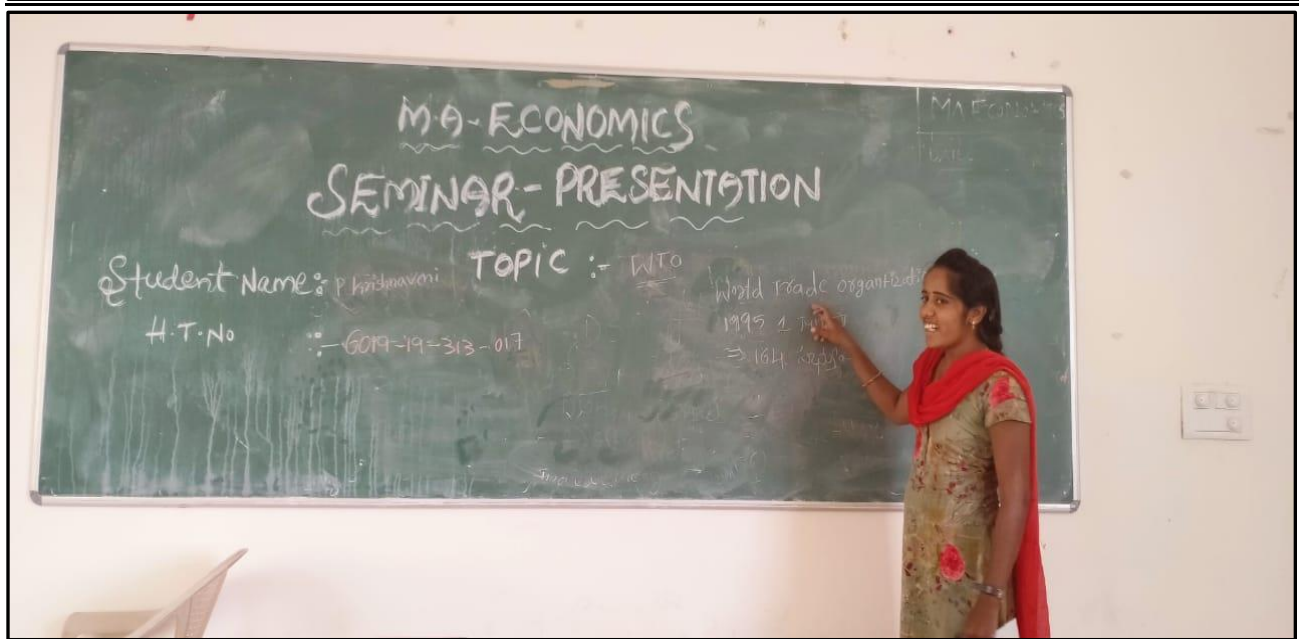














Field Trip:
